

REMEMBER THE SABBATH TO OBSERVE IT

WELCOME TO OUR SHABBAT SERVICE GUIDE

Prosperity is found in the most unlikely places! For instance, hidden in our Father's commandment to remember and keep the Sabbath holy is one of the mechanisms that will bring true and lasting prosperity. He promises to bring it about in your life and your loved ones. We know this to be true and seen it play out in many lives. However, due to locations where there is not a Messianic Congregation available or due to circumstances where you are not allowed to gather in a Messianic Congregation, you may still be able to gather in your homes. The following is outline for how you can gather your family and friends in your home to experience a Shabbat service that will enrich your lives in many different ways. Thanks for your interest and we hope this makes your in home Shabbat Service more meaningful!

Texts:

- Mark 2:27 - "...The Sabbath was made for man, not man for the Sabbath."
- Leviticus 23:3 - "Six days shall work be done, but on the seventh day is a Sabbath of solemn rest, a holy convocation. You shall do no work. It is a Sabbath to the Lord in all your dwelling places."
- Isaiah 58:13-14 - "If you turn back your foot from the Sabbath, from doing your pleasure on my holy day, and call the Sabbath a delight and the holy day of the Lord honorable; if you honor it, not going your own ways, or seeking your own pleasure, or talking idly; then you shall take delight in the Lord, and I will make you ride on the heights of the earth; I will feed you with the heritage of Jacob your father, for the mouth of the Lord has spoken."

Invites:

We encourage you use an invite service like Paperless post (<https://www.paperlesspost.com/>) or Evite (<https://www.evite.com/>).

- Invite people one week ahead of time.
- Add the location, times, and a description of your get together.
- You can also assign who brings what.
- Paperless Post or Evite will keep it all organized and easy to follow up with.

Format:

- Start Time - 11:30am MST
 - Start by sharing a meal together!
 - There are so many ways to share a meal: have people sign up to bring different things, make the main dish and assign side dishes, host a potluck, or BBQ and everyone brings their own items to BBQ along with their favorite side to share.
- Pray and start the meal - 12:00pm MST
- Wrap up meal - 12:45pm MST
- Shabbat Service - 1:00pm MST
 - Get everyone assembled to watch and participate in the Harvest's live stream service by 12:55pm.
 - For directions on how to access our livestream visit graftedin.com > Teachings > Livestream
- Afterglow/Prayer time - following the end of the Shabbat service
 - Immediately after the service, spend some time asking the group one or more of the following questions and then pause to pray for them. Limit answers to 1-2 minutes.

Questions:

- What did you find important and encouraging in this service today?
 - Where/in what area is God challenging you at this time in your life?
 - What would you like prayer for?
- Formal Dismissal - following the end of afterglow/prayer time
 - Have a closing prayer to dismiss everyone so people can leave gracefully when the time comes. You can always extend the time for people who want to stay and fellowship.

Preparing For Your in Home Service:

- Get prayed up during the week. The enemy will try and distract you and derail you as you get closer to your in home Shabbat Service. Be aware of this and derail his plans by staying close to God and asking Him for His strength, power, and courage to lead a Shabbat Service in your home.
- Have FUN and spread the joy of the Lord to all those around you!
- Remember - You are not alone. We stand with you and are praying for you!
