2026 is almost here! In preparation for the new year, we want you to have essential information about important events we have to offer at Legacy Youth. In this package there are six trips offered by Alabama Youth Ministries (AYM) that we attend as a group throughout the year. AYM is an organization comprised of our state-wide fellowship of churches and youth ministries within the Alabama Assemblies of God under the direction of our elected Network Youth Director, Ben Russell.

We believe that each of the trips that are offered here are top-tier events that can be lifechanging. There is something special about getting away from the normal routine and experiencing a move of God. Each of these trips will have multiple female and male adult leaders, and at all overnight trips, guys and girls will have separate rooms monitored by adults with background checks. (Girls Conference is a female-led, girls only trip.) We believe the cost of these events are well worth the money, but we are aware of the expense. From experience, the best three in quality and value are Summer Camp, Youth Convention, and Deeper Weekend. We want to give you this information in enough time to prepare for the expense and help you understand the investment you are making. We typically challenge students to consider ways to work for some extra money to cover the expense, and if possible, invite a friend who doesn't go to church and offer to cover their expense too. There will be opportunities for sponsorship if necessary. In our generous church, we do not want money to be the only hindrance that keeps a student from going on a trip that could potentially change their life and walk with Jesus.

Lastly, there are nine events or series of events listed that we host throughout the year which are almost all completely free. This list is extensive, but not comprehensive, so there may be other events throughout the year that we host or participate in. The Legacy Youth calendar is packed full of opportunities to invite friends, have fun in celebration, and grow in relationship with God.

Speed the Light Tour | Friday, January 9, 2026

Speed the Light is a fundraising organization for teenagers to get involved with giving to missions. Speed the Light funds primarily buy vehicles for missionaries planted across the world. Water wells, sound systems, and other essential items are also purchased by Speed the Light. In 2024, in Alabama alone, \$919,017 was raised, and Legacy Youth gave \$13,000. At the beginning of each year, we come together with youth groups of Assemblies of God churches across north Alabama to celebrate Speed the Light and be challenged to give as we set the goal for the year for Legacy Youth. We will host this event in the Legacy Youth Room this coming January.
