February and March, either Tuesdays or Thursdays from 12:30 - 1:30 p.m.

No experience needed – the curriculum and all materials are provided. Martha Moore-Keish is a thoughtful and engaging teacher who helps people make sense of Christian faith as it is actually lived, not just studied. With clarity, honesty, and practical wisdom, she invites communities to wrestle with big questions about God, responsibility, and life together. She is the J.B. Green Professor of Theology at Columbia Theological Seminary, and earned a Ph.D. in theology from Emory University. She will join us on February 1 to teach on the Christian practice of truth telling—how naming our missteps and telling the truth about ourselves and our world opens the way toward healing and wholeness. We are so pleased that Dr. Moore-Keish will continue visiting with Covenant on the First Sundays in March and May to continue the conversation.
