# Field Trips

Field trips are taken when appropriate and include pumpkin patches, Imaginon Theatre and The Nutcracker. Older preschoolers (Fours and Fives) enjoy yearround field trips. Children in the Threes classes and younger do not leave school, but we welcome special visitors who share hobbies and jobs with them. The Preschool is open to suggestions regarding excursions or visitors. Parents may be asked to transport children for field trips.



Covenant has three state-of-the-art outdoor playgrounds. Our youngest classes access their playground from their classrooms. During inclement weather, indoor playground equipment is set up on the gym floor in the church Recreation Wing.

## Music and Movement

Students have music and movement class to sing, dance and play musical instruments while developing their self-esteem, expressing their feelings and learning to follow directions. Our program meets the needs of the children rather than expecting children to adjust to the demands of a specific program.



## **Art Studio**

The Art Studio at Covenant Presbyterian Preschool offers multi-dimensional art opportunities for our children that go a step further than the artwork that is done in the classroom. The light-filled space allows children to experiment with paint mixing, light and reflection, patterns and woodworking.

# **Gym Time**

Kevin Harper, our Recreation Ministry Director, provides stretching, exercise, manipulative skills and cooperative games for all students on a regular basis throughout the year.

#### Preschool at Covenant

Covenant Presbyterian Church extends its ministry to young children (1 to 5 years of age) and their families through its Preschool, which is comprised of preschoolers from various religious, racial and social backgrounds.

#### We Believe

- Each child is unique and endowed with gifts from God.
- Children share their thoughts and ideas through creative expression.
- Children learn best in an interesting and loving environment, which encourages freedom of choice and self-expression.

#### We Provide

- A child-centered, developmentally appropriate approach.

- Experience with open-ended materials that encourage exploration.
- Activities in music, art, drama and dance to encourage creative expression.
- A curriculum with a variety of themes that allows children to explore their interests and discover their gifts.
- Opportunities to grow spiritually, cognitively, physically, emotionally and socially.

# Children's Ministry

We encourage a child's faith through monthly Chapel, blessings at lunch, and Bible stories. We also participate in mission projects such as lunches for Covenant's Room in the Inn guests, donations to Loaves & Fishes and our Christmas Giving Tree.

#### Staff

Our teachers are experienced and dedicated professionals who communicate with parents on classroom curriculum and offer parent/teacher conferences when requested.

#### Hours

Children are dropped off in their classrooms at 9 a.m. Pick-up is 12:30 p.m. Preschoolers bring their lunch. The office is open weekdays from 8:30 a.m. - 1:30 p.m.

#### Schedule

Our program operates on a September to May calendar. We generally observe the same holiday schedule as public schools and utilize some of their Teacher Work Days. A yearly calendar is published online and in the Parent's Handbook.

# Class Sizes and Teachers

Classes will be formed on the basis of registrations received and enrollment will be limited to the following class sizes:

- One's: 2 Teachers, 9 Children
- Two's: 2 Teachers, 10-12 Children
- Three's: 2 Teachers, 15-16 Children
- Four's/Five's: 2 Teachers, 16-17 Children
- PreK/TK: 2 Teachers, 16-17 Children

#### **Tuition Schedule:**

2 days per week \$350 per month

3 days per week \$415 per month

4 days per week \$480 per month

5 days per week \$570 per month

Transitional Kindergarten \$575 per month

One month's tuition is due May 1, 2026 to hold your child's place. This payment is applied to May, 2026. Monthly tuition is due the first day of each month and can be made by cash, check, automatic draft or credit card. Late notices (with a \$10 late charge) will be emailed on the 15th of each month.

**Activity Fee:** A one-time \$50 activity fee per child will be added to September's monthly tuition to support in-school enrichment offerings such as music, gym, and the art studio.
