BIBLE STORY

Harvest Kids is focusing on learning and reciting all 66 books of the Bible from memory and have a general idea of what each book is about by using motions.

Now that Genesis through Songs of Solomon are covered, it's time to move to the major prophets, Isaiah through Daniel. The children will learn that the major prophets were men who delivered God's messages to his people.

The minor prophets didn't write as much as the "majors," but they all delivered important messages. Hosea through Malachi reminds the people of God's love and forgiveness, and tries to warn them not to make the same mistakes their ancestors had.

New Testament time!

Matthew, Mark, Luke and John are up next! The gospels are the books that change the whole story of the Bible. Jesus has come to fulfill the prophecies, to pay the price for our sins and set us free.

The children will learn about some history again in the book of Acts. After Jesus returned to Heaven, the church began to spread. The more people opposed the gospel, the faster it grew! Acts tells the incredible story of the early church and it's followers like Saul/Paul.



Harvest Hope has been providing support for children and adults with disabilities in all areas of the church since 2015. They believe that, as Christians, it is their mission to show the unconditional love and grace of Jesus Christ to ALL people. It is this belief that drives them to encourage and support individuals, and their families, with cognitive, physical, or emotional challenges, through involvement in typical church activities.

Harvest Hope not only serves in the church but also in our community. They serve adults with developmental disabilities during the week with activities held at Harvest.

They serve two ways on Sunday mornings during first service. Harvest Hope has a teens and young adults Bible study that meets in the attic and will go with a child to their age group class to assist if needed. They are willing to serve second service if needed.

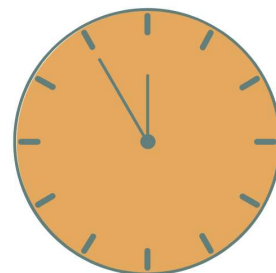

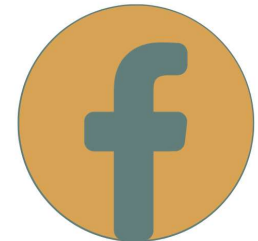
