- Current Topic: Conversations with David Byers and Hunter Twitty on Faithful Christian Living

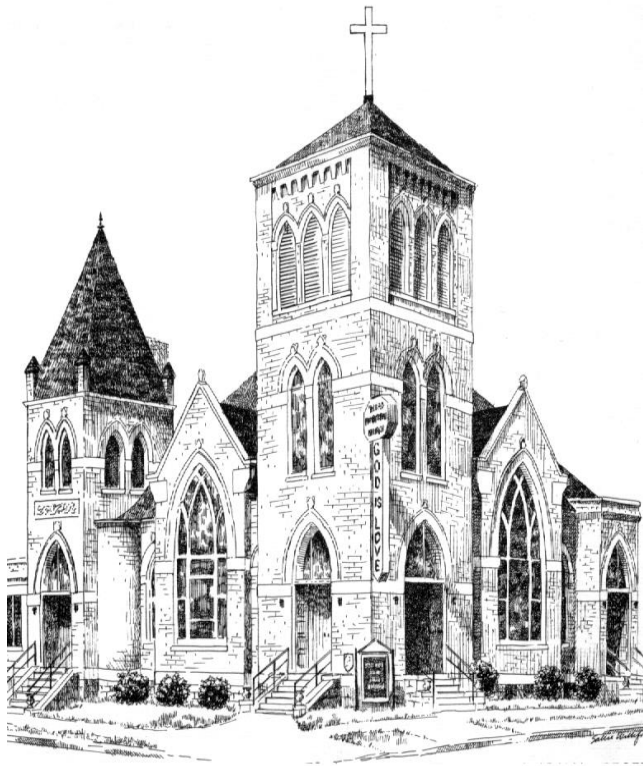
