Note: In addition to the above collections, the Church received an additional \$185,000 in December gifts earmarked for a particular 2026 Church need. Of this sum, \$150,000 was received by the Church that historically was dedicated to the General Operating Fund. When considering this, the Church would have met all 2025 collection and expense Budget goals. In other words, our giving is on an upward trajectory (not including that \$150,000 special gift). Finally, the 2026 budget does not include the \$150,000 gift.


