1. Living Under God's Word

2. Pursuing God-Honoring Relationships

3. Reordering Rhythms Around Worship

4. Honoring God with Our Resources

Discussion Questions:

1. In the sermon, we looked at the "Power of 4" - how spending time in Scripture at least four days a week has been shown to significantly impact spiritual growth. Are you engaging God's Word regularly enough for it to take root and bear fruit? What might be keeping you from a consistent rhythm in the Word?

2. God's people committed to pursuing God honoring relationships. Are there friendships, relationships, or habits of compromise pulling you away from God's best for your life?

- 3. God's people recommitted to the Sabbath by trusting God with their time and work. In what ways are you and your family prioritizing regular rhythms of rest and worship? Are you giving God your best time each week? Have other things like sports, work, or rest taken priority over worship? Nehemiah 10:31; Hebrews 10:24-25
- 4. Even under economic pressure, God's people gave generously to support worship. Take some time and reflect on the way you use the finances and time God has given you. What does this reveal about what we value most? What would it look like to put God first in your finances? What about with your time?
