NEHEMIAH: THE BUILDER OF WALLS

NEHEMIAH 2 | PASTOR CHUCK KLEINHESSELINK

The Build Up - *"Why does your face look so sad when you are not ill? This can be nothing but sadness of heart?" (v.2)*

The Request - *"If it pleases the king and if your servant has formed favor in his sight, let him send me to the city in Judah where my fathers are buried so that I can rebuild it." (v.5)*

"Let us come boldly to the throne of grace, that we obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need." (Hebrews 4:16)

Nehemiah's Secret - *"I went to Jerusalem, and after staying there three days I set out during the night with a few men. I had not told anyone what my God had put on my heart to do for Jerusalem. There were no mounts with me except the one I was riding on." (v.11-12)*

"We are hard pressed on every side, but not crushed; perplexed, but not in despair; persecuted, but not abandoned; struck down, but not destroyed." (2 Corinthians 4:8-9).

"Then I said to them, 'You see the trouble we are in: Jerusalem lies in ruins, and its gates have been burned with fire. Come, let us rebuild the wall of Jerusalem, and we will no longer be in disgrace.' "(v.17).

"They replied, 'Let us start rebuilding.' " (v.18)

"The God of heaven will give us success." (v.20)

1. What made Nehemiah's prayer before he spoke to the king significant?
2. What place does planning serve when we pray?
3. How would you describe Nehemiah's leadership style?
4. What place does God's provision and favor play in our study of Nehemiah 2?
