NEHEMIAH 4 | CHUCK KLEINHESSELINK

He Prays -

"Hear us, O Lord, for we are despised. Turn their insults back on their own heads. Give them over as plunder in a land of captivity. Do not cover up their guilt or blot out their sins from your sight, for they have thrown insults in the face of the builders."

vs. 4-5

"they did so with all their heart" vs. 6

Persevering Prayer -

"But we prayed to our God and posted a guard day and night to meet this threat."

vs. 9

"Those who carried materials did their work with one hand and held a weapon in the other, and each of the builders wore his sword at his side as he worked." vs. 17-18

"There is so much rubble that we cannot rebuild the wall." vs. 10

"Our God will fight for us!" vs. 20

"So we continued the work with half the men holding spears, from the first light of dawn till the stars came out." vs 21

1. What resources do we have when opposition is fierce?
2. How do we combine prayer and work in our lives?
3. Do we have a tendency to emphasize one more than the other?
