

### Piedras Negras: A Great Trip and Lasting Impact

What a great trip! The experience at Piedras Negras was powerful and deeply moving. It's clear that the donated items change lives. A significant part of our time was spent in the bike shop, where several bicycles were fixed. These bikes were in really rough shape, but they now have new tubes and some have new tires. These kids wear bikes out like nothing we ever see. They're happy tearing around on bald tires and torn seats, a testament to their joyful, energetic spirit.

In addition to the mechanical repairs, a critical safety improvement was made: commercial exterior lights were installed under their covered breezeway. It was an OSHA nightmare before, but Destin Charette, a licensed electrician and church member, wired everything up professionally, with help from our members and the older boys.

The connection with the children was immediate and profound. The kids work right alongside you; often picking up the tool you just sat down. They watch what you're doing and mimic on the next bike. The connection is powerful. Although language can be a barrier, Google Translate is your best friend. We even played a language game with the kids to build relationships before lunch.

Before we left, they extended a heartfelt invitation to have worship with them. Pastor Ricardo led the service, and the kids played instruments and sang their guts out. Later, we had our chance to lead the singing. These are life memories you can't buy... but they are free to those who come.

They are currently asking for some simple necessities: paper towels and sandwich bags. If you're looking for a chance to serve, come and be changed or contribute to Mission Piedras Negras. We have just scratched the surface. This mission has no line item in the budget; it is funded through your contributions and the pockets of those serving. - Joe Stuller
