



# PRAYER POINTS

"Blessed is the nation whose God is the Lord", Psalm 33:12

July 1st: We pray for God's Sovereign Hand to lead our nation, to turn each face to Himself and to gain a personal knowledge of His Word.

July 2nd: We ask for wisdom and discernment for our national leaders, President Trump and Vice President Vance, as they have the great responsibility of protecting the United States of America and her values.

July 3rd: We ask that our country's original values be strengthened and protected in order that we may freely live as Christians and raise generations that will be able to do the same.

July 4th: Today, we thank God for those 56 men who stood in the face of tyranny and committed their lives to build a nation based on principles in God's Word by signing the Declaration of Independence.

July 5th: As we gather to Appeal to Heaven as a church this evening, we ask the Lord to continue to give mercy on us, a country that was established on His Word and by conviction, so that we may see a revival in our lifetimes.

July 6th: We pray for all of our elected representatives, that they would lead in a way that we may live tranquil and quiet lives in all godliness and dignity. (1 Timothy 2:2)

July 7th: Lord, we humbly ask for your forgiveness as a nation, for the continual practice of aborting babies across our country by the rampant use of the abortion pills. We pray that our lawmakers would create and protect legislation that would defend the lives of the unborn across our nation.

July 8th: We join with all of Tennessee as we ask for God's healing hand of mercy across our state. (House Joint Resolution 51)

July 9th: We pray for wisdom for our state leaders, Governor Lee (TN) and Governor Kemp (GA), as they both close out their terms, that the Lord would grant them favor and confidence to protect conservative values.

July 10th: We ask the Lord to give courage to our state representatives to stand for true conservative values and not bend the knee to selfish ambitions and motives.

July 11th: We pray for our local leadership, Hamilton County Mayor Weston Wamp and Chattanooga Mayor Tim Kelly, that they would lead in efforts to promote our Constitutional freedoms.

July 13th: Today we pray for wisdom for our County Commissioners as they continue to create and operate budgets that reflect the needs of our community but that also steward our tax dollars well.

July 14th: We pray for Choices Pregnancy Center, as they continue to help new moms and dads choose life in the vulnerable moments. We pray for resources from across the community so they can continue to offer the Abortion Pill Reversal programs we so desperately need.

July 15th: We pray for protection over the leadership and staff of Calvary Chapel Chattanooga, that the Lord would strengthen their marriages and families.

July 16th: We pray for each ministry represented through Calvary Chapel, that God would continue to guide each ministry team to bless those who call this church their home.

July 17th: We pray that the Lord would bring fruit to each missionary that we partner with. We ask that each marriage would be strengthened, that each family be united, so that the work of the Gospel can go forth in their communities.

July 18th: We pray for our Family Ministry, that each child who participates would meet Jesus in a personal and profound way.

July 24th: We pray for each family in our fellowship, that through them, generations of children would be taught to honor God and honor the authority in their homes.

July 25th: We ask the Lord to continue to teach us how to be a people of principle, a people who choose morality and exemplify godly character in our homes and workplaces.

July 26th: We ask for courage to stand for Jesus and represent the fruit of the Spirit in our workplaces, so that others may see the character of God through us.

July 27th: Lord, we pray for an outpouring of your Holy Spirit on each of us, that we would come to a deeper understanding of who You are and where You want to lead us.

July 28th: We ask that each of us would not be conformed to this dark age, but that we would be transformed by the renewing of our minds, by the reading of His Word and finding Godly community in our church fellowship.

July 29th: We pray that you would help us lead lives of integrity, that we would exhibit self-control so that those around us would recognize the power of the Holy Spirit in our lives.

July 30th: Heavenly Father, we recognize that in order to influence our country, we must honor You, we must live as people of righteousness, and we must submit our lives to You so that Your perfect will may be done in each of us.
