We are a church that cares about families. We want to support families and to connect families with Jesus. As a result, when Church Family Night restarts on September 3, **we will be launching a new group for moms**. This is an opportunity to love the families that God has given to DPC and to connect with other families in the community. **If you are a mom (especially with kids at home), we'd love for you to be there and to bring others with you. If you are not a mom, or no longer in the season of life with kids at home, we are asking you to reach out to those around you.**

Having this group gives you a way to invite friends at work, school, or from your neighborhood **without it feeling weird**. Everyone knows that the mom-life can be hard and that encouragement and community are good. So **here is everything you need to know** to sign-up or to invite someone else:
