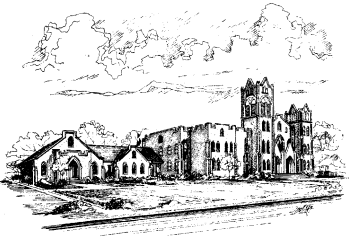

COMMUNITY CONNECTIONS

Our church family has volunteered to host the breakfast for Community Connections on Saturday, December 6. We usually arrive at the temporary location, the old Darlington Builders Supply building, now the City Recycling Center area, 586 West Broad Street, by 7:30am to set up inside. We are usually finished by 9:30. We now serve around 200-250 plates, which consist of:

- Twenty-two (22) breakfast casseroles
- Two (2) large pots of grits – ten (10) to fifteen (15) pounds
- Fresh fruit or fruit cups – Sam’s has the fruit cups in volume [twenty-four (24) count]
- Mini-doughnuts or mini-muffins [three hundred fifty (350)]
- Bottled water or small orange juice

Also, if you have extra Bibles, these would be appreciated. Socks or blankets would be great to share during this cold weather. A sign-up sheet is posted on the window outside the church office if you would like to sign up to volunteer to serve and/or donate items. -Missions Committee
