From Your Interim Pastor

Mark Twain wrote, "The secret to getting ahead is getting started." His piece of homespun wisdom readily applies to the life of a Christ follower.

If you are thinking about becoming a Christ follower, get started and see where the journey with Christ leads. The same applies to church membership, praying often, taking on a "handson" ministry, reorienting time and resources around Christ, making amends, forgiving someone, reading the Gospels, and the like.

Obstacles to getting started include inertia and fear. Inertia is the tendency to continue moving in the same direction at the same speed unless influenced by outside forces. Face it. We tend to hold on to established patterns of time usage, mental focus, thinking, speech, and commitments. Getting started on change requires a conscious decision to depart from our norm.

Fear may be the greatest impediment to getting started. We fear the reaction of others, making a mistake, unforeseen consequences, and leaving the familiar behind. When fear threatens to root you in place, remember the promise of Jesus: "And, lo, I am with you always." When we start to move, Christ travels with us.
