Dates: June 25- July 2, 2024 **Location:** San Jose, Costa Rica

Ministry: Community Engagement, Evangelism, House Building

A country of 5 million people, Costa Rica has long been heralded as the adventure tourism capital of the world. It is no wonder their national slogan is "Pura Vida" – the pure life. The country is also bordered by Panama and Nicaragua but boasts greater economic stability and human development than neighbors in the region, making it a desirable safe haven for refugees from Nicaragua, Colombia, and other nearby countries. Within this breath-taking nation is also a beautiful people group in need of Jesus. With over 75% of the population identifying with Catholicism, this nation is still in need of a relationship with the Savior.

While with This Mission, you will have the chance to share the gospel in some of the poorest neighborhoods of San Jose. With a focus on the prevention and aftercare for those affected by trafficking, ministry opportunities will fit in this framework as well. Ministry will vary from befriending girls who were once trafficked, passing out Bibles and praying in neighborhoods, to playing soccer with kids. We will also be building a new house for a family in need. We are excited for you to see how God is using His people in Costa Rica!

Trip Involvement and Requirements

The Outreach Trip is a 9-month commitment. The following are requirements for participation on this trip:

Finances

50% of trip cost is due on April 14th. If you do not have 50% of the trip cost by this date you forfeit all monies raised on your behalf and will be denied participation on the trip. This is non-negotiable.

100% of trip cost is due on June 2nd. If you do not have 100% of the trip cost by this date you forfeit all monies raised on your behalf and will be denied participation on the trip. This is non-negotiable.

If for some reason you choose to not participate or are denied participation there will be <u>no refunds of monies donated to Victory Faith Fellowship</u>.
