

When I was growing up, my family would often go to Crested Butte, Colora-

do in the summertime for vacation. It's such a beautiful place to enjoy the wonders of God's creation. One of our favorite activities was hiking the mountain. Instead of hiking up the mountain, we chose an easier plan of riding the chair lift up the mountain and then hiking down This was probably a good idea for fairly inexperienced hikers. It is so tempting for each of us to do our own thing and not follow as He leads. I pray that as we live our lives, we would know God's ways, follow His path, and wait on Him.
