roles

MENTOR

A mature, Christian woman who intentionally shares with her mentee - with transparency, honesty and authenticity - what she has learned in order to encourage the mentee's spiritual growth. Mentors are required to attend one-on-one meetings (see FAQ) with mentee each month.

MENTEE

A woman seeking an intergenerational mentoring relationship to build up her faith in Christ Jesus. Mentee is required to attend one-on-one meetings (see FAQ) with mentor each month.

PRAYER WARRIOR

A woman who lifts up in prayer the mentor/mentee pair as a line of defense against the Enemy's schemes and for the spiritual growth of both women. Prayer Warriors are not required to attend meetings with mentor and mentee (see FAQ).

Due to the nature of a mentoring relationship, all participants agree to create an atmosphere of respect and confidentiality.

frequently asked questions

DO I NEED TO BE WELL-VERSED IN THE BIBLE TO BE A MENTOR?

No. These mentoring relationships are meant to be mutually encouraging to the growth of each other's faith, not a relationship of professor and student.

HOW MUCH TIME COMMITMENT IS INVOLVED?

The monthly commitment is determined by each individual trio. While it is recommended that mentors and mentees meet at least 2x/month, how often and the duration of the meeting time is scheduled at your convenience. Prayer warriors are not required to attend meetings but are required to check in regularly with mentor and mentee for prayer request updates.

ARE FACE-TO-FACE MEETINGS REQUIRED?

No, but highly encouraged! Sometimes meeting face-to-face will not be an option, and technology can be utilized such as FaceTime, Skype, Facebook Messenger, or even talking on the phone.

DOES TITUS2GETHER FOLLOW A SPECIFIC FORMAT?

No. Each mentee will have her own goals for her spiritual growth (i.e. disciple of prayer, scripture memory, evangelism, etc.). Each Titus2gether trio decides what to focus on during their time together (i.e. go through a book, book of the Bible, scripture memory, etc.). Each participant will receive a training book which provides a recommended book list and ideas for meeting together.

WHAT HAPPENS AT THE END OF THE 6-MONTH PERIOD?

Evaluations of the Titus2gether program are provided for participants to provide feedback to the coordinators for the improvement of the program. Participants also decide whether to continue together as a trio for the next six months, take a break, or participate in a new trio.
