4-10-22 Sermon Notes "When Jesus Comes to Town"

The Gospel of Mark gives us a really different, thought-provoking account of "Palm Sunday." What do I mean by "different?" Well, in Matthew's account (Matt. 21), the whole city of Jerusalem is in turmoil when Jesus enters, and Jesus goes right over to the temple and drives out the buyers and sellers, overturning tables and such. In Luke's account (Luke 19), Jesus weeps over Jerusalem, and then once in the city, He enters the temple and drives out the buyers and sellers. In John's Gospel (John 12), Jesus doesn't even go to the temple on Palm Sunday. He had already cleansed it at the beginning of the Gospel. Instead, John has Him entering the city and beginning to teach.

But Mark? Mark says that Jesus entered the temple, looked around...and left. Doesn't that make you wonder, "Why did Jesus leave Jerusalem and the temple backtrack to Bethany?" That seems sort of, well, anticlimactic. Mark 11: 11 tells us that Jesus went back "because it was already late." What if Jesus was late getting somewhere He needed to go – late doing something He needed to do? Hmmm... Let's look at Mark's Palm Sunday account:

When they were approaching Jerusalem, at Bethphage and Bethany, near the Mount of Olives, he sent two of his disciples ² and said to them, "Go into the village ahead of you, and immediately as you enter it, you will find tied there a colt that has never been ridden; untie it and bring it. ³ If anyone says to you, 'Why are you doing this?' just say this, 'The Lord needs it and will send it back here immediately.'" ⁴ They went away and found a colt tied near a door, outside in the street. As they were untying it, ⁵ some of the bystanders said to them, "What are you doing, untying the colt?" ⁶ They told them what Jesus had said; and they allowed them to take it. ⁷ Then they brought the colt to Jesus and threw their cloaks on it; and he sat on it. ⁸ Many people spread their cloaks on the road, and others spread leafy branches that they had cut in the fields. ⁹ Then those who went ahead and those who followed were shouting,

"Hosanna!

Blessed is the one who comes in the name of the Lord! ¹⁰ Blessed is the coming kingdom of our ancestor David! Hosanna in the highest heaven!"

¹¹ Then he entered Jerusalem and went into the temple; and when he had looked around at everything, as it was already late, he went out to Bethany with the twelve. (Mark 11: 1-11 NRSV)

Late for what? Curious minds want to know! Well, join us this Palm Sunday to find out! Also, we are going to have "Donkeys and Donuts!" How could you resist that? Don't you want to know what happens when Jesus comes to town?





Remote Area Medical: RAM Clinic April 22-24, 2022

R.A.M. April 23 & 24, 2022, Gadsden City High School

Free dental, vision and medical services are provided on a first-come, first-served basis beginning at 6 am. (Parking opens at 11:59 pm on Friday, April 22 and will remain open.) Due to time constraints, be prepared to choose between DENTAL and VISION services. Medical services are offered to every patient attending the clinic. https://www.ramusa.org/event/gadsden-al-2022/

Patients will be required to wear a face-covering and must undergo a COVID-19 screening before entering the clinic. All services are free and open to the public. No ID required. In some situations, such as inclement weather, volunteer cancellations, or other circumstances outside of RAM's control, the parking lot may open earlier or a smaller number of patients may be served. RAM encourages everyone who would like services, especially dental services, to arrive as early as possible.

RAM's Corps of more than 172,900 volunteers—licensed dental, vision, medical, and veterinary professionals—have treated more than 863,700 individuals delivering more than \$174 million worth of free care.




