Isaiah 61:10-62:3
Common English Bible
10 I surely rejoice in the Lord;
my heart is joyful because of my God,
because he has clothed me with
clothes of victory,

wrapped me in a robe of righteousness like a bridegroom in a priestly crown, and like a bride adorned in jewelry.

11 As the earth puts out its growth,
and as a garden grows its seeds,
so the Lord God will grow righteousness and praise before all the nations.

Jerusalem redeemed

62 For Zion's sake I won't keep silent, and for Jerusalem's sake I won't sit still until her righteousness shines out like a light, and her salvation blazes like a torch.

2 Nations will see your righteousness, all kings your glory.

You will be called by a new name, which the Lord's own mouth will determine.

3 You will be a splendid garland in the Lord's hand, a royal turban in the palm of God's hand.

When this Sunday rolls around, Christmas day will have passed. We often think of the celebration being over, but in reality the party is just beginning! Isiah reminds in this passage to not be silent about our joy. Share the hope and love that Emmanuel brings. In the chaos of 2020, we have the joy of Christ that we can celebrate. Guidelines for End of Year Contributions

In order for contributions to be posted to your **2020** giving record, they must meet one of these requirements:

- **1.** The gift is received and posted to your account before December 31st.
- **2.** The contribution is put into the offering plate on December 27^{th} or delivered to the office on or before <u>December 30th</u>.
- **3.** The envelope in which the gift is mailed is <u>postmarked</u> on or before December 31st.
- **4.** An online E-Giving transaction is dated on or before December 31st.
- **5.** Gifts of stock should be transferred before the market closes on December 31st. Please inform Jane at the office about a stock transfer.




