Surprisingly, the responses did not include The Perfect One, Jesus. We who follow him, need to be reminded that "perfect Christmas" begins and ends with Jesus. However, we can experience perfect love in Christ.

There is also a sign-out sheet beside the Angel Tree, so be sure to sign your Angel # out so we can know which angel you have selected.





Guidelines for End of Year Contributions:

In order for contributions to be posted to your 2023 giving record, they must meet one of these requirements:


- 1. The gift is received & posted to your account before December 31st.
- 2. The contribution is put into the offering plate or delivered to the office on or before December 29th.
- 3. The envelope in which the gift is mailed is postmarked on or before December 31st.
- 4.An online E-Giving transaction is dated on or before December 31st. (Find link at fumcgadsden.org/giving)
- 5. Gifts of stock should be transferred before the market closes on December 29th. Please inform the financial office at the church about a stock transfer.

During the month of October, we journeyed through Generosity: New Beginnings. In this emphasis you were invited to consider how God is calling you to a new beginning and how you are committing to a new beginning. Through the spiritual disciplines of prayers, presence, gifts, service, and witness God transforms us and makes us new. God may have called you to a new prayer emphasis, or a renewed commitment to worship. The Lord might have invited you to tithe or a new avenue of service. God could have nudged you to invite someone to church or share your faith in another way. I am excited to hear about all the new beginning at First United Methodist Church of Gadsden.

If you have not made a commitment to your new beginning and completed your estimate of giving card, I encourage you to do so. Fifty-three giving units within the church have done so already. Your card may be turned into the church office, in the offering plate, or electronically on the church website/app. If you have lost your card, blank estimate of giving cards are available at the information table in the Chestnut Street lobby. Please turn your card in as soon as possible, this helps the leadership plan for 2024 and to be good stewards of resources. Remember that your estimate is just an estimate, and not a binding contract. The information is kept confidential with the financial secretary. In addition to the logistical aspect of stewardship, this year's card includes a space for you to indicate and commit to how God might be calling you to step up in 2024.
