February 19, 2023 **Jesus' Transformation** 

17 Six days later Jesus took Peter, James, and John his brother, and brought them to the top of a very high mountain. <sup>2</sup> He was transformed in front of them. His face shone like the sun, and his clothes became as white as light.

<sup>3</sup> Moses and Elijah appeared to them, talking with Jesus. <sup>4</sup> Peter reacted to all of this by saying to Jesus, "Lord, it's good that we're here. If you want, I'll make three shrines: one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah."

<sup>5</sup> While he was still speaking, look, a bright cloud overshadowed them. A voice from the cloud said, "This is my Son whom I dearly love. I am very pleased with him. Listen to him!" Hearing this, the disciples fell on their faces, filled with awe.

<sup>7</sup> But Jesus came and touched them. "Get up," he said. "Don't be afraid." <sup>8</sup> When they looked up, they saw no one except Jesus. <sup>9</sup> As they were coming down the mountain, Jesus commanded them, "Don't tell anybody about the vision until the Human One<sup>[a]</sup> is raised from the dead." Matthew 17:1-9 CEB

This Sunday is when we celebrate Transfiguration Sunday! In our passage, the disciples see Jesus transformed. What they saw was utterly amazing, his clothes and face became like a bright light! In the gospel of Luke, Jesus is described as having clothes like lightning, and in Mark Jesus's clothes are described as dazzling. Did you notice that not only is the appearance of Jesus completely different, but we have people who have been dead for a long time appear at the scene? The disciples are amazed and in wonder. They fall and worship Jesus. Let's gather this Sunday and worship Jesus in awe and wonder. Let us also discuss why Moses and Elijah show up at this event, why they ended up seeing only Jesus, and what transfiguration means for us! I look forward to seeing everyone on Sunday!



- 1 Standard Size Claw Hammer
- 1 Shirt Pocket Notebook, 1 Permanent Marker,
- 1 Pencil and Sharpener in a Ziploc Bag
- 12 Black 30-45 Gallon Trash Bags
- 1 Roll of Toilet Paper in Zip Lock bag

Work Gloves-Leather Palm or All Leather Gloves

- 50 Count #8 Nails
- 10 White 13 Gallon Trash Bags with drawstrings.
- 1 Cellophane Packing Tape
- 10 One Gallon Zip Lock Bags
- 1 Box Cutter
- 1 Hand Sanitizer (4oz to 12 oz)
- 1 Insect Repellant Spray or Can, or Wipes or combination
- 1 pair Safety Glasses
- 6 Clear 40 -55 Gallon Trash Bags
- 3 Tampons or Pads in a Zip Loc Bag






