

It's time to put in your King Cake orders for 2024. Once again, we are selling King Cakes from Randazzo's bakery in Slidell, LA. There are several flavors and two sizes in each option. Last year, we hoped to sell at least 100 cakes but due to your generosity and campaigning we sold 409. The bakery has a maximum order of 500 cakes per fundraiser.

This sale, we will be collecting orders through an online method only. We feel that this will be the best way to manage the orders and not exceed the maximum number allowed. We have an order link on the church website: www.fumcgadsden.org/elc. Payment will be collected through PayPal or cash or check dropped off to the church within 24 hours of ordering.

The fundraiser is currently open, and all orders and money are due by Friday, January 19. This will give plenty of time to review all the orders and count the money before giving a grand total per item to the bakery. Sheila Freeman and I will be driving to Slidell to pick them up on Thursday, February 1.

Your Mission Team will be leading the way to once again fill Tornado Buckets for the UMCOR Disaster Relief Warehouse in Decatur! This year, we will be collecting donations of items for the buckets so that those can then be divided up and packed!

You can help by donating multiple quantities of the same item or by sponsoring a tornado bucket. The estimated cost of the items for one tornado bucket is \$120. We hope to have lots of buckets ready to take to our Disaster Relief Warehouse

I wanted to follow up on Generosity: New Beginnings. In this emphasis you were invited to consider how God is calling you to a new beginning and how you are committing to a new beginning. Through the spiritual disciplines of prayers, presence, gifts, service, and witness God transforms us and makes us new. God may have called you to a new prayer emphasis, or a renewed commitment to worship. The Lord might have invited you to tithe or a new avenue of service. God could have nudged you to invite someone to church or share your faith in another way. I am so excited about all the ways First United Methodist has stepped up and responded. Many of you have answered the call to follow God into a new discipline in the coming year. This new commitment includes an increased commitment to giving, with a greater amount pledged for 2024 and being just three commitments shy of surpassing last year's number of pledges.

If you have not made a commitment to your new beginning and completed your estimate of giving card, I encourage you to do so. Your card may be turned into the church office, in the offering plate, or electronically on the church website/app. If you have lost your card, blank estimates of giving cards are available at the information table in the Chestnut Street lobby. Your commitment is not a binding contract but helps the leadership plan for 2024 and to be good stewards of resources. The information is kept confidential by the financial secretary. In addition to the logistical aspect of stewardship, this year's card includes a space for you to indicate and commit to how God might be calling you to step up in 2024. If you are planning on carrying your 2023 commitment to the coming year, please let our financial secretary, Sheila Witherspoon, know even if the amount remains the same. All of this allows you to be a part of new beginnings which are happening here.

I am so excited about the year ahead. By the power of the Holy Spirit, I can feel that God is doing a new thing at First United Methodist Church, and I am blessed to be on this journey with you!



Dorothy grew up in Gadsden and attended Carver High. She received a Bachelor's degree in Secondary Education from Jacksonville State, with a double-major in English and History. Dorothy taught at Carver High, then when the school principal became ill, was appointed the school's Administrative Assistant to handle all of his duties, a job which she held until the school closed in 1972. She then worked at Alabama Technical College as an instructor in Vocational Rehabilitation for the State of Alabama, finding suitable vocations for people with disabilities. After returning to the University of Alabama and to Auburn to receive a

Counselor 3 level of training in Vocational Rehabilitation, she worked for 23 years at Gadsden State before retiring. She has served as a "Voting Inspector" for many years, overseeing the operation of two precincts. She also became the Director of the Gadsden-Etowah Tourism Board after serving on the board for 30 years. She was on the board for Gadsden's winning "All-America City" bid, as well as on the Beautification, Red Cross, United Way, Salvation Army, and Darden Rehabilitation boards. She was one of the Founders of the Carver Museum and Fellowship Baptist Church. Dorothy has two children: Angela Hood and Robert "Bobby" Robinson.
