

7-9-23 Sermon Notes "Extraordinary Together" Romans 12:3-8

In his letter to the Romans, Paul encourages them to "present their bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship". He then goes on to share about various gifts which graciously have been given to us by God. Some are given gifts of ministry, teaching, generosity, leadership, compassion, and cheer. All of these are to be used for the work of Christ.

Paul's words challenge us to consider how we present our bodies as a living sacrifice. When we join the church, we are not given a list of ways that the church serves us (The Church does bless us, but that is not the purpose or mission of the church), but we are asked how we will support the church? Our commitment is to support the church with our prayers, presence, gifts, service, and witness. Church is not for spectators, but we are commissioned to be Christ's body for a world to know Christ. Do you pray for the church? Do you attend worship when you are in town and not sick? Do you give generously? Do you serve? Do you share Jesus with others and invite people to church? Do you use your God given gifts to glorify the Lord?

This week, we continue our journey in "Extraordinary". God uses ordinary people like me and you to be the Church. He uses our gifts to show people Jesus. Isn't it extraordinary that the sum of our gifts is truly greater in God's hands?

Did you know....

That you can reduce your taxes by making a gift from your IRA to your church? An IRA rollover is a simple and easy way for you to use your IRA to help Gadsden First United Methodist Church fulfill its mission.

DOES AN IRA ROLLOVER MAKES SENSE THIS YEAR

If you are like many donors with the new tax law, you could be paying higher taxes this year. By transferring some of your IRA required distribution to the church, you can lower your taxable income and capital gains taxes this year. Check with your advisor to see how an IRA rollover gift could impact your taxes while helping the ministries and missions of the church.

Recently congress authorized IRA Rollover. This means that if you are 70 1/2 or older you can make a charitable gift of up to \$100,000 from your IRA. Your gift will qualify for your required minimum distribution and you will not have to pay federal income tax on the amount given from your IRA to qualify.

HOW TO MAKE AN IRA ROLLOVER GIFT TO GFUMC

To make an IRA rollover gift simply contact your custodian and request that an amount be transferred to GFUMC. Your gift could be \$1000, 10,000, 50,000 or any amount up to \$100,000.
