

Sermon Notes: 3.12.23 "How Is It?"

One evening a husband was helping his wife in the kitchen (no, this is not a joke), and as they were getting ready to put the pot roast in the pan, his wife took a big knife and cut the end of the roast off and put it in a smaller pan. Her husband asked her why she did that, and she said, "That's the way my mom always did it." The more he got to thinking about it, the more he wondered - so he called his mother-in-law. "Why do you cut the end off of your pot roast and put it in a separate pan?" She answered, "Well, that's the way my mom always did it."

The man was not satisfied with that answer, being curious by nature. After a fitful night's sleep, he got up the next morning and went to see his wife's grandma in the nursing home. "Grandma," he said, "I've just got to know. Why did you always cut the end off your pot roast and put it in a separate pan? Did it make the roast more tender and juicier? Is it an old family secret that you brought over from Ireland?" Grandma just smiled and shook her head. "Heavens no, child. The reason I cut the end off my pot roast was because my pan was too small."

I wonder if we ever stop and ask why things are done the way they are. The question that sticks out to me in our gospel passage for this Sunday (John 4: 5-42) hits at the heart of this. Three little words... "How is it?" How is it: that Jesus leaves Judea and starts back to Galilee?... that he goes through Samaria to get there?...that he stops at Jacob's well?...that a Samaritan woman shows up at noon to draw water?...that he asks this woman for a drink of water?

If we can keep asking questions, we will have a better chance of learning all that God wants us to learn

from Scripture.




