May 1, 2022 Sermon Notes "So, What Now?"

There's an indie rock band called "The Shins," and I sort of like their music. It's kind of mellow and puts me in a relaxed mood. I particularly like a song they have called, "So Now What?" It's about a couple who has seen their lives and their relationship shift. Verse one says,

Oh girl, it's been a while Since we met, out there in the cold Seems so long ago It's hard not to imagine The lives we used to have When nights we're always alone So now what?

Now this guy is lonely, and it's hard for him not to look back and imagine what it was like before... And he asks, "So now what?"

This reminds me of what Peter and the other disciples must have experienced after Easter...after they met the Resurrected Lord...after they heard Jesus' words, "As the Father has sent me, so I am sending you." In John 21 (which is sort of an "epilogue" to the gospel) Simon Peter answers the (unspoken) question, "So what now?" by saying, "I am going fishing." The others who were with him (Thomas, Nathanael, James and John and two other unnamed disciples) said in reply, "We will go with you." (John 21: 1-3)

Do you remember how that worked out for them? "They went out and got into the boat, but that night they caught *nothing*." (John 21: 3) After experiencing the Resurrected Christ, going "backwards" to the old life as a fisherman is not a good choice. Jesus comes to them (like always), and calls from the beach, "Children, you have no fish, have you?"

What does Jesus have against fishing? Nothing! Jesus tells them to cast their nets on the other side of the boat, and they caught so many fish they couldn't haul the net back into the boat. Once they got back to the shore, Jesus cooked breakfast for them, and in a very memorable conversation with Simon Peter, Jesus shows all of them the answer to the question, "So what now?" Would they coast along? No. The chorus to the song I mentioned before goes like this:

I had this crazy idea
Somehow we coast to the end
Change lies in every direction so now
I guess we'll just begin again

Would they go backwards? No. Jesus called them to begin again as fishers of people, and also shepherds of those new disciples.



over and above your regular tithes and offerings.


Over the years, the way our members have decided
