"Pentecost and the Power of Commencement" 5-28-23 Sermon Notes

Am I the only one who has noticed that May has been a very busy month? I have heard more than one person say, "May is the new December." That's the way it has seemed to me. Now we have reached a milestone Sunday - Pentecost. Let's remember what happened that day:

2 When the day of Pentecost had come, they were all together in one place. ² And suddenly from heaven there came a sound like the rush of a violent wind, and it filled the entire house where they were sitting. ³ Divided tongues, as of fire, appeared among them. and a tongue rested on each of them. 4 All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other languages, as the Spirit gave them ability. 5 Now there were devout Jews from every people under heaven living in Jerusalem. ⁶ And at this sound the crowd gathered and was bewildered, because each one heard them speaking in the native language of each. 7 Amazed and astonished, they asked, "Are not all these who are speaking Galileans? 8 And how is it that we hear, each of us, in our own native language? 9 Parthians, Medes, Elamites, and residents of Mesopotamia, Judea and Cappadocia, Pontus and Asia, 10 Phrygia and Pamphylia, Egypt and the parts of Libya belonging to Cyrene, and visitors from Rome, both Jews and proselvtes. 11 Cretans and Arabs—in our own languages we hear them speaking about God's deeds of power." 12 All were amazed and perplexed, saying to one another, "What does this mean?" 13 But others sneered and said, "They are filled with new wine." 14 But Peter, standing with the eleven, raised his voice and addressed them, "Fellow Jews and all who live in Jerusalem, let this be known to you, and listen to what I say. 15 Indeed, these are not drunk, as you suppose, for it is only nine o'clock in the morning. ¹⁶ No, this is what was spoken through the prophet Joel: 17 'In the last days it will be, God declares, that I will pour out my Spirit upon all flesh, and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams. 18 Even upon my slaves, both men and women, in those days I will pour out my Spirit, and they shall prophesy.

¹⁹ And I will show portents in the heaven above and signs on the earth below, blood, and fire, and smoky mist.²⁰ The sun shall be turned to darkness and the moon to blood, before the coming of the Lord's great and glorious day. ²¹ Then everyone who calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved.' (Acts 2: 1-21 NRSV)

As I said, May has been a busy month. One of the things we have been busy with is graduations. ELC graduation, Striplin Kindergarten graduation, High Schools, Colleges... I love the word that is often used for graduation ceremonies: commencement. It comes from the word "commence" - from the Latin "com" (meaning "together") and "initiare" (meaning "begin"). Commencement, then, literally means to begin together. Beginning together is what the Day of Pentecost is all about! Join us this Sunday as we talk about the power of the Church's

Commencement.

First UMC Gadsden's Mission Team hosted Kindergarten Graduation for Striplin Elementary School! Over 500 people attended. What an awesome day!


Teacher Appreciation Luncheon




Retirement and Farewell Luncheon
