Sermon Notes May 30

"Do You Remember?"

Tomorrow we will celebrate Memorial Day in our country. It used to be known as "Decoration Day," and it is still called that by some folks. Memorial Day originated in the years following the Civil War, but didn't become an official federal holiday until 1971. Many Americans visit cemeteries or memorials that day. Communities have parades...families have gatherings... Did you know that each year on Memorial Day, a national moment of remembrance takes place at 3:00 pm local time? Whom do we remember on Memorial Day? We remember all those who died in wars in our country from 1775 – Present...a number that, according to statistica.com, adds up to almost 1.2 million people. Will you remember their sacrifice? I hope so. Remembering is a very big part of what we do every Sunday when we gather for worship. I like the way Rob Webber puts it in his book, Ancient-Future Time: "Every Sunday is a 'little Easter'...The work of the people in 'doing the Christ event' through memory and hope is the source for personal and corporate formation into resurrection spirituality." Just by the fact that we gather on Sunday – the day Jesus rose from the dead – means that we are remembering.

This Sunday, we will use Isaiah's vision in Isaiah 6: 1-8 to remember (1) Who God is (2) Who we are (3) What God can do (4) What we can do.

> In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord sitting on a throne, high and lofty; and the hem of his robe filled the temple. ² Seraphs were in attendance above him; each had six wings: with two they covered their faces, and with two they covered their feet, and with two they flew. ³ And one called to another and said:

> "Holy, holy, holy is the LORD of hosts; the whole earth is full of his glory." ⁴ The pivots on the thresholds shook at the voices of those who called, and the house filled with smoke. ⁵ And I said: "Woe is me! I am lost, for I am a man of unclean lips, and I live among a people of unclean lips; yet my eyes have seen the King, the LORD of hosts!"

⁶ Then one of the seraphs flew to me, holding a live coal that had been taken from the altar with a pair of tongs. ⁷ The seraph touched my mouth with it and said: "Now that this has touched your lips, your guilt has departed and your sin is blotted out." 8 Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, "Whom shall I send, and who will go for us?" And I said, "Here am I; send me!" (Isaiah 6: 1-8 NRSV)


