As Moses was instructing the people, giving them the law, he warned them when they entered a land of prosperity, to not forget God. He encouraged them to recall what God has done and give thanks by keeping God's law. Moses knew that it would be easy for the Israelites to be distracted and forget to be grateful. Without remembrance and grateful hearts, it would be easy for them to fail to keep God's commands. So, Moses called them to remember and be thankful. (Deuteronomy 8:7-18)

This Thursday and Sunday, we prepare for Thanksgiving with worshipping God. Isn't this where thanksgiving should start? Worship is adoration and praise of God. A life of thanksgiving is one filled with adoration and praise to God, the source of all our many blessings. This week, I encourage you to not forget to praise God from whom all blessings flow. Like with Moses lesson to the Israelites, remember where God has led you and take stock of the blessings which are before you. As the hymn goes, "Count your blessings and see what God has done." #### **Basketball Team Practice Time Requests**

Scheduling Requests for use of the First UMC Gadsden Gym for Youth Basketball practice must be turned in by November 15, 2023. Once all requests have been received, team practice times will be finalized and approved by the church office. Each team is required to submit the following documents to the church prior to the first practice.

- 1) Coach's Acknowledgements of Safe Sanctuary Policy and Gym Use Rules
- 2) Team Roster
- 3) Emergency contact information for Coach and Sponsor.

The goal of Gadsden First United Methodist Church is to care for children and youth and administer to their needs in responsible ways. This includes helping to ensure their safety with trained security monitoring the building and following our Safe Sanctuary policy. Both help protect participants, coaches, parents, and FUMC from dangerous situations, unforeseen hazards, and potential liability. Therefore, Gadsden First United Methodist Church has instituted new rules regarding the use of the gymnasium for basketball practice. These rules start for the 13-week time period between mid-November 2023 to mid-January 2024.

This policy is for practice only. Member-based teams receive priority over non-members. One-hour practice sessions for basketball are limited to Monday, Tuesday, Thursday nights. The gym is not available for practice on Tuesdays from 5- 6 pm or anytime on Wednesday nights. Church events or other scheduled activities may take priority over basketball practice times. Please refer to the complete GFUMC Facility Use Policy for more information. Effective this season, GFUMC is asking for a one-time, minimum donation of \$500 from each basketball team for the season. Any additional donations are appreciated. This donation serves to help offset building and security expenses.

### **GEORGE FANT**



God may have called you to a new prayer emphasis, or a renewed commitment to worship. The Lord might have invited you to tithe or a new avenue of service.
