Sunday November 26 Sermon Notes "Preparing for Holy Seasons"

Something unusual happens in the Christian calendar this year. Advent does not come right after Thanksgiving. Instead Advent doesn't begin until December 3. We get an extra week of giving thanks and preparation for the holidays ahead. So, how do we prepare for the upcoming holidays? The key is in the root of "holiday." This word has its origin in once being called "holy days." Thus, we prepare for holidays by remembering that the upcoming holidays are "holy days" from the Lord. In Zechariah's story (Luke 1:5-20), we meet a priest who had an unusual encounter with the Holy. The angel Gabriel came to Zechariah in the holiest part of the temple and announced that he and his wife would have a child in their advanced age and this child would be favored by God. A messenger from the Lord brought incredible news of a miracle baby. Zechariah's story reminds us of God's Holy Presence, messages, and activity on a holy day in his life. May God's presence, messages, and activity be with us as we prepare and experience the holidays which are ahead for us.


as well as watching Football and other sports played at the University of Alabama.

During the month of October, we journeyed through Generosity: New Beginnings. In this emphasis you were invited to consider how God is calling you to a new beginning and how you are committing to a new beginning. Through the spiritual disciplines of prayers, presence, gifts, service, and witness God transforms us and makes us new. God may have called you to a new prayer emphasis, or a renewed commitment to worship. The Lord might have invited you to tithe or a new avenue of service. God could have nudged you to invite someone to church or share your faith in another way. I am excited to hear about all the new beginning at First United Methodist Church of Gadsden.

If you have not made a commitment to your new beginning and completed your estimate of giving card, I encourage you to do so. Fifty-three giving units within the church have done so already. Your card may be turned into the church office, in the offering plate, or electronically on the church website/app. If you have lost your card, blank estimate of giving cards are available at the information table in the Chestnut Street lobby. Please turn your card in as soon as possible, this helps the leadership plan for 2024 and to be good stewards of resources. Remember that your estimate is just an estimate, and not a binding contract. The information is kept confidential with the financial secretary. In addition to the logistical aspect of stewardship, this year's card includes a space for you to indicate and commit to how God might be calling you to step up in 2024.


