#### A Letter from Your Pastors

10.12.22

Dear Church Family,

The last couple of months have been filled with lots of conversations, meetings, prayers, and speakers about the subject of staying with or disaffiliating from the United Methodist Church. This all led up to our church conference



vote on September 27, at which time we had a total of 254 votes cast – 68.5% voting to remain UMC and 31.5% voting to disaffiliate. That being the case, we will continue to be a United Methodist Church, serving in the heart of the City of Gadsden.

It has been a stressful time in the life of this church. I want to commend the hard work of the Pathways Task Force – Mark Condra, Joni Smith, Harry Vance, Debbie Hiltz, Karen Owen, George Varner, and Keith Copeland – for their hard work and dedication to provide all our members with every opportunity to hear from all sides of this sensitive issue. Every person had a chance to ask their questions and voice their opinions. We tried to do everything in a spirit of love and cooperation.

As your pastors, we love each and every one of our members! It saddens us that some may choose to leave our church to unite with another congregation. No one was asked to or is expected to leave. We will continue to love all and we will continue to welcome all who come our way and want to walk their faith journey along with this church family.

What does it mean that we are remaining a United Methodist Church? It means that we will continue to follow and abide by the same *Book of Discipline* of the United Methodist Church, and that we will still be a part of the connection in the North Alabama Conference and the Mountain Lakes District. No changes in the polity of our denomination are possible unless voted on and approved at General Conference in 2024. Nobody can predict for sure what will happen at that time.

What will happen to the United Methodist Churches who voted to disaffiliate? Once their disaffiliation is voted on at the called Annual Conference on December 10, 2022, and once they have paid the costs associated with disaffiliation, they will no longer be United Methodist Churches.

Things will look different in the North Alabama Conference after 2022. Facing change can be unsettling. Please rest assured that God is with us, that you are loved, and that Gadsden First United Methodist Church continues to remain focused on our mission: *Sharing Christ, Making Disciples, Serving, and Giving Hope.*

For those who have lost a pet recently, you are invited to bring a photo to place on our Memorial Wall.


This blessing event is a chance to give thanks for all God's Creation, especially our pets and the special place they hold in our hearts and lives. We look forward to seeing you and your pet.
