9-4-22 Sermon Notes "What Have I Gotten Myself Into?"

Discipleship's Demands Luke 14:25-33 CEB

(25)Large crowds were traveling with Jesus. Turning to them, he said, (26) "Whoever comes to me and doesn't hate father and mother, spouse and children, and brothers and sisters—yes, even one's own life—cannot be my disciple. (27) Whoever doesn't carry their own cross and follow me cannot be my disciple. (28) "If one of you wanted to build a tower, wouldn't you first sit down and calculate the cost, to determine whether you have enough money to complete it? (29) Otherwise, when you have laid the foundation but couldn't finish the tower, all who see it will begin to belittle you. (30) They will say, 'Here's the person who began construction and couldn't complete it!' (31) Or what king would go to war against another king without first sitting down to consider whether his ten thousand soldiers could go up against the twenty thousand coming against him? (32) And if he didn't think he could win, he would send a representative to discuss terms of peace while his enemy was still a long way off.

(33)In the same way, none of you who are unwilling to give up all of your possessions can be my disciple.

What Have I Gotten Myself Into? Have you ever asked yourself. "What have I gotten myself into?" Maybe after you purchased a home that needed way too much work, after starting a new job, after beginning a new relationship, or after committing to running in a race? When reading this scripture, I imagine some in the crowd following Jesus heard Jesus talk about the cost of being a disciple and must have thought, what did I get myself into? This Sunday, let's look at this scripture, let us count the cost, let's talk about what it means to pick up our cross daily. Following Jesus is serious. For some it might change our social status (think about who Jesus ate with), it may change our time management, where we live, how and who we serve. May we all reevaluate what it means to be a disciple this Sunday. We will also partake in Holy Communion this Sunday.

Etowah Free Clinic

Gadsden First UMC Missions supports The Etowah Free Clinic. This clinic provides uninsured patients of Etowah County with access to physicians, nurses, support staff, prescription medication and a variety of holistic care services, at no cost. The clinic has had a dramatic impact, not just in the lives of those they serve, but also in the community in which they live, work and play.

Local physicians volunteer their time to treat patients at the clinic, and make necessary referrals to participating specialists who treat patients in their offices. They treat people for diabetes, hypertension, thyroid disorders, high cholesterol and other chronic conditions which, when left untreated, can lead to life-threatening complications and lengthy stays in the hospital.

Acute conditions are also treated, often requiring nothing more than a simple antibiotic. The EFCC is able to provide treatment to patients who would otherwise arrive at the emergency room with no means of payment or go without treatment.


