"Team Loyal"

When you joined First United Methodist Church, you were asked, "As members of Christ's universal church, will you be loyal to the United Methodist Church, and do all in your power to strengthen its ministries?" *Loyalty* can be defined as faithfulness and allegiance and is part of our membership vow, along with prayer, presence, gifts, service, and witness. How do we live out this loyalty as followers of Jesus Christ? The prophet Elijah ministered in a time when the peoples' loyalty was not pure, so he challenged them by asking "How long will you waiver between two opinions? If the Lord is God, follow Him, but if Baal is god, follow him."

I Kings 18:17-24. The people were called to declare their allegiance and be faithful. This Sunday, we are going to look at "Team Loyal." Just like with football teams, loyalty to the Church can be a mixed bag. With football, one minute you have some fans praising the team, and the next calling for a change in playing positions or coaching staff with a single loss. If *loyalty* is a virtue, how can we cultivate it as other disciplines? How can we grow in allegiance and faithfulness to Christ's Church?





KIRK & JEANNE MABEUS





DID YOU KNOW...

That you can reduce your tax exposure by making a gift from your IRA to your church? An IRA Qualified Charitable Withdrawal (QCD) is a simple and easy way for you to use your IRA to help GFUMC fulfill its mission.



DOES AN IRA QCD MAKE SENSE THIS YEAR?

If you are age 70 ½ you can use pre-tax dollars in your IRA to donate to the church. This amount is capped at \$100,000.

If you are age 73 (for tax year 2023), this amount can be used to satisfy your Required Minimum Distribution.

Check with your tax professional to see how an IRA QCD could impact your taxes while helping the ministries and missions of the church.
