



GOD'S GOT A PLAN

Materials Needed:

- *Blank puzzle template (pre-cut puzzle sheets OR printed outline of a blank puzzle on cardstock)*
- *Crayons, markers, or colored pencils*
- *Scissors (if using printed puzzle templates)*
- *Glue sticks or tape*
- *Construction paper (to mount the completed puzzle pieces)*

- *Optional: stickers, glitter glue, magazine cutouts, gems, etc. for decorating*

Instructions:

1. Introduce the Craft (Talk It Out First):

Begin with this thought:

“Just like a puzzle, God created each of us with a specific purpose. We may not always understand how our piece fits, but God does. Every gift you have—whether it’s kindness, helping others, singing, or even making people laugh—is part of the bigger picture of His plan.”

2. Distribute Puzzle Template:

- Give each child their own puzzle sheet*
- If you're doing individual puzzles, 4–6 pieces per puzzle is ideal for younger kids. Older youth can work with more pieces.*

3. Decorate Each Piece:

On each puzzle piece:

- Write or draw **a gift, talent, or goal** you believe God has placed in your life.*
- Use colors and decorations to make it meaningful.*
- Use your creativity! You can use words, symbols, drawings, or cut-out pictures.*

4. Cut Out Puzzle Pieces:

If not pre-cut, cut along the lines carefully. (For younger kids, pre-cut the puzzle pieces.)

5. Assemble the Puzzle:

- Mount it on a piece of construction paper or poster board.*
- Glue the pieces together to form the puzzle again.*
- Title it “**My Puzzle of Purpose**” or “**God’s Plan for Me.**”*
