

All Things New (Part 2) – Revelation 22

Revelation 20 details the 1,000 year millennial reign of Jesus Christ and his servants upon this Earth.

Revelation 21 establishes a new Heaven and Earth and the New Jerusalem is brought down from _____ (Col. 3:1-2; Matt. 6:10). Moving into eternity, there are key things that no longer exist as **time concludes**: No more *temple* (21:22), no more *separation from God* (21:1, 3), no more *death, sorrow, crying, or pain* (21:4). God has reversed all tragedies and Heaven and Earth are staged to glisten with perfection.

A NEW Paradise in and beyond New Jerusalem – Revelation 22:1-5, 14

1. **The river of life** flows from God the Father and the Lamb's throne – v. 1; Gen. 2:10; Jn. 4:10-14.
2. **The tree of life** shows up again with more details than the Genesis account – v. 2.
 - The original purpose of the tree of life was to eat of it and live _____ – Gen. 2:9; 3:22, 24.
 - The tree of life appears to be nourished by the river of life – v. 1; Ezek. 47:12.
 - This unusual tree grows on either side of the river and in the midst of the street bearing twelve kinds of fruit that yield for _____ months. The leaves from this supernatural tree are used for the healing of the nations – Rev. 21:12-13.
 - At some time in the past, the nations were divided according to the _____ of the children of Israel. Every person is also born in a particular month – Rev. 21:24-26; Deut. 32:7-9; Acts 17:26.
 - Only those who obey God's commandments can enter New Jerusalem and partake of the tree of life and live forever...just as with Adam and Eve at the beginning – v. 14; Gen. 3:22, 24.
3. **The curse** that has hindered life from Genesis 3 to the Millennium is finished – v. 3; Gen. 3:17-19.
4. **The servants** of the Lord are marked, serve Him face to face, and reign with Him forever. The abode of God's Kingdom will not be in _____ – v. 3-4; Gen. 32:30; Ex. 33:20-23; Matt. 5:8; Dan. 7:14, 18.

5. **An eternal day** begins with the Lord that never ends– v. 5; Gen. 2:1-3; 1 Thess. 4:17; Eph. 3:21.
