2024 CURRICULUM

Beginning in 2024, Temple Students will be embarking on a sermon series teaching chronologically through parts of the Old Testament. Our main goal is to show that the whole Bible is one big story of redemption from beginning to end, all pointing to Jesus as the main character.

BIBLE READING PLAN

As we teach through our 2024 curriculum, we will be pointing students to read parts of the Old Testament as a community.

Because part of our desire is to support your family in spiritual growth, we want to invite you to take part in this journey as well, and encourage you to go through the reading plan as a family.

STUDENT LEADERSHIP TEAM

In 2024, we want to give students an increased role in the ownership and stewardship of their ministry. We recognize that the Lord has specifically gifted our students, and that them utilizing their gifts is essential to the ministry's growth and health.

Students interested in being on the team will go through an application/interview process, and will commit to a monthly discipleship meeting where they will be trained and equipped in a biblical model of spiritual leadership. Throughout our various Temple Student events and gatherings, these students will have specific roles and responsibilities.

APPALACHIAN MINISTRY OF THE SMOKIES

Temple Church has had the privilege of serving alongside AMOS for over 20 years, and we are prayerfully considering taking our second group of high schoolers to serve next Spring Break. Located in the Appalachian Mountains, AMOS serves families living in substandard living conditions and provides resources to combat locational poverty.

Our main focus as a group would be construction work on the home(s) that we are assigned. Some students who are unable or uncomfortable doing that sort of work may have opportunity to serve within the Ministry Center, which takes in and organizes supplies and food to bless the surrounding community.


