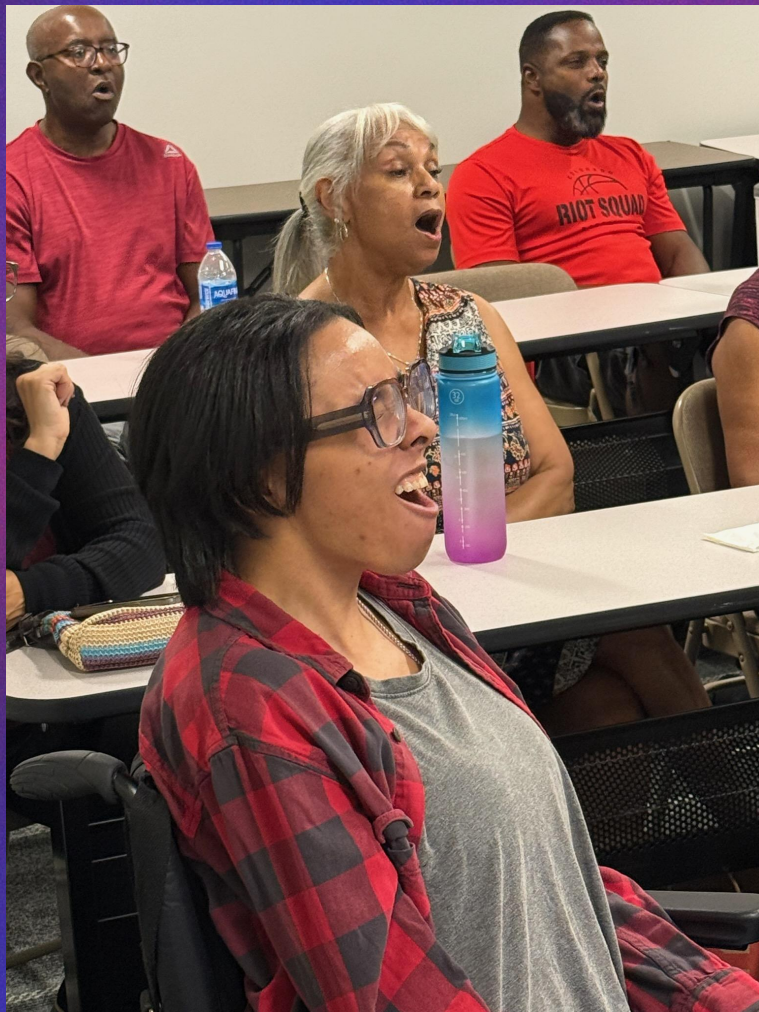

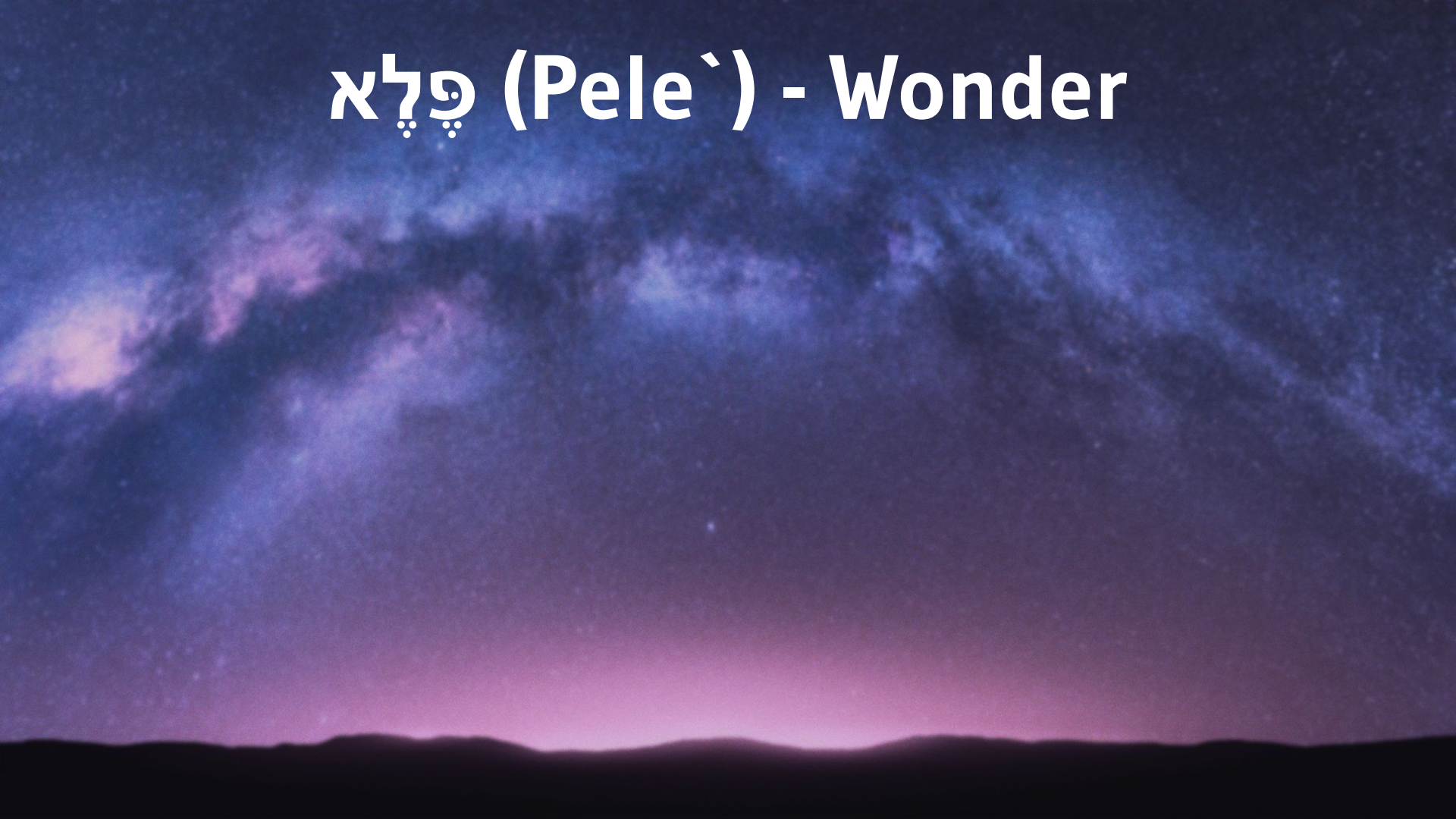
Wonder (Noun)

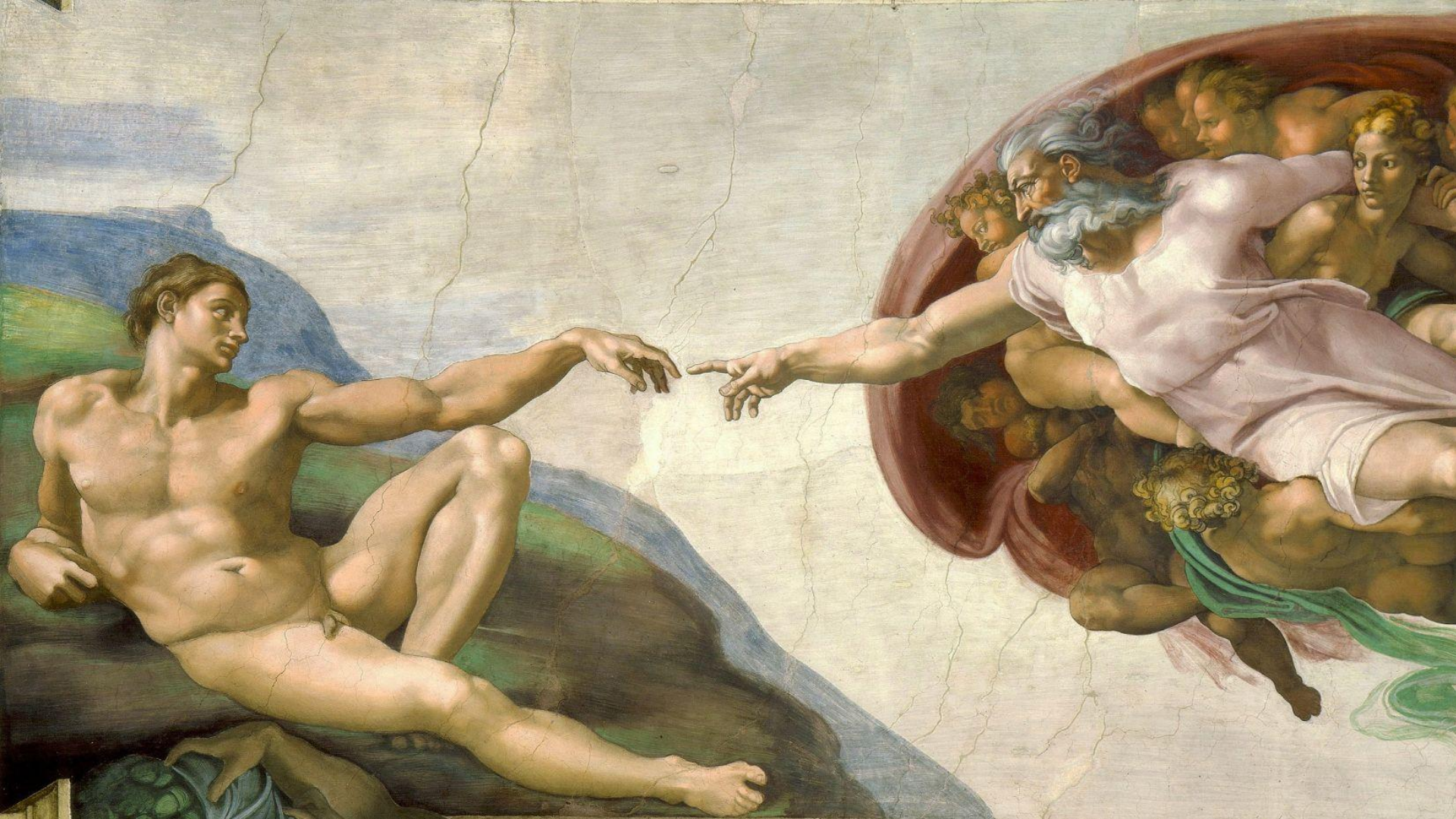

We can marvel when we experience the moments when God reveals Himself from the supernatural realm into our natural world, leaving us inspired to both learn and teach, with declaration and proclamation, from our mouths.

Covenantal Context

These “wonders” are not random displays of power, but covenantal acts that unveil God’s character and His relationship with His people.

Has any other people heard the voice of God speaking out of fire, as you have, and lived? Has any god ever tried to take for Himself one nation out of another nation, by testings, by signs and wonders, by war, by a mighty hand and an outstretched arm, or by great and awesome deeds, like all the things the Lord your God did for you in Egypt before your very eyes?
