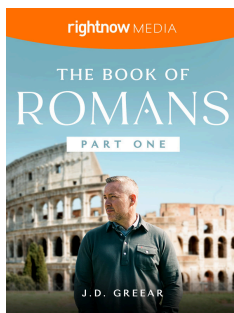

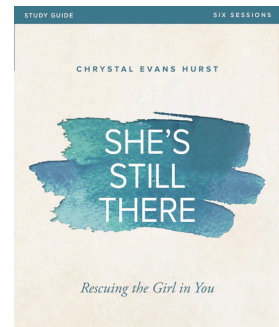
• Women's Bible Study | led by Donna Sheehan | Room W119



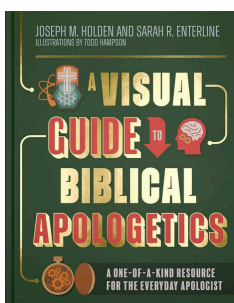
