

Last year during 10 Days, we once again saw massive growth in the Body in the most difficult places among some of the least reached people groups. We believe, based on the testimony of many, that God is releasing grace to bring many millions into the kingdom of God. God is hearing and answering our prayers to prepare the way just as He promised! Jesus, Our Great Intercessor, who ever lives to make intercession for us, invites us to join Him in yearning for and hastening His return as all things are aligned to His perfect design.

- Day One —

WE BUILD PEOPLE

We pray:

BREAK OUR HEART FOR WHAT BREAKS YOURS, FATHER



Key scripture: Nehemiah 1:3-11

A city with broken down walls represented a defeated people. The people of Jerusalem were in great distress and reproach. The inhabitants of the city were broken because the walls were broken.

"The survivors who are left from the captivity in the province are there in great distress and reproach. The wall of Jerusalem is also broken down, and its gates are burned with fire." Nehemiah 1:3

Nehemiah was broken for the broken!

"So it was, when I heard these words, that I sat down and wept, and mourned for many days; I was fasting and praying before the God of heaven." Nehemiah 1:4

Living God's way means making His priorities our priorities, even when they are different from ours. As Christians we are often waiting for our "great escape" from this broken world when God is wanting us to be about His business of bring hope, health and healing to a hurting world through the Good News of Jesus Christ.

Prayer:

Heavenly Father reveal to me what's on your heart today. Break my heart for what breaks yours. Give me your heart for the lost and broken. As Nehemiah responded and the Prophet answered your call in Isaiah 6:8 so I hear your voice today and say "Hear I am! Send me." I will ARISE AND BUILD!





HUMBLE YOURSELVES

Adoration:

Lord Jesus Christ, Name Above All, You didn't consider equality with God a thing to be grasped but humbled Yourself and took on the form of a servant, becoming obedient unto death, even death on a cross, and now You have been exalted to the highest place. [Phil. 2:5-9] We humble ourselves under Your authority and acknowledge that You are worthy to receive all praise, honor, glory, and worship. You willingly became Sacrificial Servant and now are the Sovereign Savior; the Lamb that was slain is now the Lion of the Tribe of Judah. Take Your rightful place on the throne of my heart as I lay down my life before You, a living sacrifice. [Rom. 12:1-2]



Repentance:

Forgive me for self-seeking, selfishness, and exalting myself. Forgive me for putting anything or anyone before You. Show me anything I have held onto aside from You or anything I have refused from You; empower me to walk fully in Your ways.

FOR A DESIRE FOR PERSONAL AND CORPORATE PRAYER



Key scripture: Nehemiah 1:3-11

"Men and women are needed whose prayers will give to the world the utmost power of God; who will make His promises to blossom with rich and full results. God is waiting to hear us and challenges us to bring Him to do this thing by our praying. He is asking us, to-day, as He did His ancient Israel, to prove Him now herewith." Behind God's Word is God Himself, and we read: "Thus saith the Lord, the Holy One of Israel, his Maker: Ask of me of things to come and concerning my sons, and concerning the work of my hands, command ye me." As though God places Himself in the hands and at the disposal of His people who pray - as indeed He does. The dominant element of all praying is faith, that is conspicuous, cardinal and emphatic. Without such faith it is impossible to please God, and equally impossible to pray." E.M. Bounds, "The Weapon of Prayer"

Nehemiah wasn't having a pity party when he was weeping over the people of Jerusalem and the condition of the walls. The news of the city didn't cause him to just sit back and complain or blame.

Nehemiah prayed and fasted. As Nehemiah was arising to take action his first action was to pray to the awesome and great God! When Nehemiah prayed he was saying "God you're my source, you're my help, I depend on you, I can't do this on my own."

As a church we can't do this in our strength. WE NEED GOD! Therefore we need corporate prayer.

Prayer:

Father you've called us to be "A HOUSE OF PRAYER!" Give me a greater desire to pray both personally and corporately. I will ARISE AND BUILD!

Adoration:

Key scripture: Nehemiah 1:1 / Nehemiah 2:1-8 / Nehemiah 3:11-17

In Nehemiah 1:1 we read that is was in the month of "Kislev" when Nehemiah was informed of the condition of the walls around Jerusalem.

In Nehemiah 2:1 we discover that Nehemiah approached the King in the month of "Nisan." There are approximately 4 months that separate these two months. What was Nehemiah doing during these four months? He was PRAYING and PLANNING!

How do we know Nehemiah was planning? Chapter 2 reveals that when Nehemiah asked the King for permission to go to Jerusalem and rebuild the walls he also had a few request of the King to help him on his journey and for supplies to begin the work once he arrived.

Nehemiah 3 tells us that Nehemiah was in the city 3 days and toured the area at night. What was Nehemiah doing? No doubt, praying and planning. You could say, "counting the cost."

"But don't begin until you count the cost. For who would begin construction of a building without first calculating the cost to see if there is enough money to finish it?" Luke 14:28

Prayer:

Heavenly Father give us your plans and strategies to reach the lost and hurting in our city and around the world. I will ARISE AND BUILD!



RIPE FOR **HARVEST**

Adoration:

Lord of the Harvest, You assure me that ripe harvest is ready in the lives of those around me. Your heart is that none should perish. May the compelling of Your love drive me and Your Spirit empower me with just the right words at just the right time with just the right person. [2 Peter 3:9; 2 Corinthians 5:14-15; Mark 13:11]

Repentance:

We pray:
TO START DREAMING
GOD DREAMS



Key scripture: Nehemiah 1:1 / Nehemiah 6:15

I believe that when Nehemiah was broken and weeping his heart became breeding ground for a God size dream. A dream that would give him a clear picture of what the walls around Jerusalem should look like. Let me stop here and say that when our hearts are broken and hurting they can also become breeding ground for despair and hopelessness.

What prevents this? Allowing God to give you a God size dream of hope and restoration! Things might look difficult and hopeless but if you'll tune in to God's frequency he wants to give you a vision and plan for your future that breathes life into your broken heart and gives you a beautiful picture of hope and restoration.

"For I know the plans I have for you," says the LORD. "They are plans for good and not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope." Jeremiah 29:11

This verse was written to people who were in captivity. I don't know what might be going on in your life right now but I know it's time to start DREAMING AGAIN! Pray, seek God, and he will give you a vision of the future he has for you! And when your life is restored God can use you to arise and build people!

Prayer:

Father give me a vision of the future you have for me. I want to dust off the dreams you've given me and once again have a clear picture of the purpose you created me for. I confess it's time for me to start dreaming again! I will ARISE AND BUILD!

Adoration:

Father God, You so loved the world that You gave Your Only Son, Jesus. Jesus, Savior and Deliverer, You came to seek and save the lost. Shepherd of the sheep, You leave the 99 to search for the one lost sheep. Thank You for Your unrelenting, faithful love. [John 3:16; Luke 19:10; Luke 15:4]

Repentance:



Forgive me for not fully appreciating the high cost You were willing to pay for my salvation. Forgive me for not valuing the souls of others as You do and working in urgency to reach them. [Mark 8:35-36; Phil. 2:5-8]

Scripture & Prayer:

"Sing to God, sing praises to his name; lift up a song to him who rides through the deserts; his name is the Lord; exult before him!" Psalm 68:4 NIV

- Pray that as Jesus followers sing worship to Him, that darkness hides and hearts open to Jesus' goodness and love.
- Pray for those suffering for righteousness' sake not to fear, but to persevere, praying for their enemies, doing good, and trusting God to protect and deliver them.

Put Feet to Your Prayers:

Then they said to one another, 'We are not doing right. This is a day of good news, and we are keeping silent; if we wait until morning light, punishment will overtake us.'" 2 Kings 7:9 & "Rescue those being taken off to death, and save those stumbling toward slaughter. - The biggest gaps in the fulfillment of the Great Commission are represented by the Frontier People Groups; choose one <u>Frontier People Group</u> to pray for daily.

Key scripture: Nehemiah 2

Is dreaming enough? Is planning enough? Is being broken for the broken enough? Is praying enough? The answer for all four questions is NO!

At some point we have to step out in faith. I believe the above process is important but the fulfillment of the dream isn't accomplished until the work of the dream begins. Nehemiah was putting his faith in action when he spoke to the King. He put his faith in action when he made the journey to Jerusalem. It was faith when he communicated to the city officials his purpose for being in their city.

"The God of heaven Himself will prosper us; therefore we His servants will arise and build," Nehemiah 2:20

One commentary said the following. "Nehemiah was the James of the Old Testament challenging the people to show their faith by their works."

In that day Israel will be the third, along with Egypt and Assyria, a blessing on the earth. The Lord Almighty will bless them, saying, "Blessed be Egypt my people, Assyria my handiwork, and Israel my inheritance." Isalah 19:23-25 NIV

- Ask God how you could concretely demonstrate love toward the Arabs, Jews and Israelis in your own community and follow through on His instructions.

Key scripture: Nehemiah 3

Nehemiah 3 reveals a remarkable display of unity! The reconstruction of the walls was a tremendous challenge. Some 40 groups worked simultaneously to rebuild the walls in just 52 days.

The successful rebuilding demonstrates Nehemiah's great ability to lead and organize but it also demonstrates the spirit of unity on the workers as they each completed their area of responsibility.

"Coming together is a beginning. Keeping together is progress. Working together is success." Henry Ford

In Nehemiah the people working together in a spirit of unity is a foreshadow of the unity of purpose and work that is to characterize the church.

"Then make me truly happy by agreeing wholeheartedly with each other, loving one another, and working together with one mind and purpose." Philippians 2:2

Prayer:

Father help me to know and do my part in fulfilling the vision of Encounter Church. Help me to work with a spirit of unity with those around me and may I continually be reminded that we can do more together for your Kingdom than I can do by myself. I will ARISE AND BUILD!

Key scripture: Nehemiah 6:1-9

After Nehemiah had completed building the wall but the doors weren't on the gates yet and they had almost completed the task. His opposition once again arises and wanted to meet with him 5 times but Nehemiah realized they just wanted to harm him.

"They were just trying to intimidate us, imagining that they could discourage us and stop the work. So I continued the work with even greater determination." Nehemiah 6:9

Nehemiah recognized the tactics of his enemy and knew their goal was to discourage him and try and get him to quit the work they were doing. Nehemiah could not afford discouragement. He had to finish the work. We must be on guard to not let discouragement replace God's Spirit resting on us or living in us.

In the Book of Joshua chapter 1 God tells Joshua several time to be "strong and courageous!"

"This is my command—be strong and courageous! Do not be afraid or discouraged. For the Lord your God is with you wherever you go." Joshua 1:9

After this they sent someone to lure Nehemiah into the "house of God", the temple, for the purpose of hiding from the enemy that was trying to kill him.

Sounds spiritual. After all Nehemiah was being asked to hide in the temple of God. But Nehemiah recognized it wasn't from God and was just another distraction.

Prayer:

Father give us discernment to recognize when the enemy is attempting to distract us from what you've called us to do. Help me to keep the main thing the main thing. I will ARISE AND BUILD!


