

November Intercessory Prayer Points

"Then he said to his disciples, 'The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few; therefore pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest." Matthew 9:37–38 (ESV)

1. Once a month walk around Sunnyside Community praying for God's will to be done and to work through Encounter Church to bring light into the darkness.

"Therefore be imitators of God, as beloved children. And walk in love, as Christ loved us and gave himself up for us,a fragrant offering and sacrifice to God." Galatians 5:1
