



September Intercessory Prayer Points

"Then he said to his disciples, 'The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few; therefore pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest.'" Matthew 9:37–38 (ESV)

1. Laborers for the Harvest (Matthew 9:37–38; Luke 10:2)

- Pray for God to raise up more workers for the Kingdom through Encounter East.
- Ask that He would send trained, committed, Spirit-filled people who are willing to serve.
- Pray for those who can write grants and steward resources wisely, so that provision flows into the ministry.

2. Provision and Resources

- Pray for open doors in grants, partnerships, and financial favor.
- Declare that God will bring skilled and instrumental helpers to strengthen the work.
- Pray that every need of the facilities is met so that Encounter East can be a strong base for the Kingdom.

3. Encounter East as a Barracks for Kingdom Warriors (Proverbs 18:10)

- Pray that the facility be a place of equipping, training, and strengthening for those God is sending.
- Declare that it will be a "strong tower" where the righteous find safety and courage.
- Pray that everyone who enters is refreshed, equipped, and sent out with Kingdom boldness.

4. Unity in the Body & Community (Colossians 1:9–12; 2 Corinthians 13:11)

- Pray that the body of Christ would be filled with the knowledge of God's will and walk in a manner worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing to Him.
- Ask that we be strengthened with all power according to God's glorious might, so we can endure and be patient with joy.
- Pray that we stand firm in unity, not allowing challenges to break fellowship.
- Ask God for a spirit of gratitude for salvation and the privilege of being part of His family.
- Pray that shared gratitude would fuel unity, reminding us that we are all on the same team, partners in the gospel, called by one God.
- Declare 2 Corinthians 13:11 over the body of Christ: Rejoice, Restore, Encourage, Live in Peace — knowing this is God's will for unity.

5. Cleansing & Purity (Hebrews 9:11–14; Hebrews 9:14)

- Pray for a cleansing of the spiritual atmosphere in Encounter East, that it will always be holy ground.
- Ask God to apply the cleansing power of Jesus' blood to our consciences, washing away guilt and freeing us from dead works.
- Pray for those who are struggling with legalism or a works-based faith, that they would understand the sufficiency of Christ's finished work.
- Ask God to reveal any "dead works" we may be trusting in instead of Christ's sacrifice.
- Pray for a deeper sense of gratitude for the new covenant and the spiritual blessings we have in Christ.
- Pray that leaders and workers walk worthy, living as examples of holiness and devotion.

6. Perseverance in Prayer (Colossians 1:9)

- Pray for continual filling with the knowledge of God's will through the Spirit.
- Pray that prayer never ceases in Encounter East—that intercession rises daily for the ministry, the city, and the nations.
- Ask God to stretch each person's faith through prayer, leading to a deeper walk with Him.
