

DANIEL—4 Community Group Questions

Daniel 4:28-37

1—Where have you seen the Lord work in your life this week? Did you meet anyone new at worship this past Sunday? Did you invite them to your community group?

2—Review Daniel 4:1-27. Note that Daniel 4 is King Nebuchadnezzar's faith testimony. The king has another troublesome dream and Daniel steps in to interpret. What was the king's dream? What is Daniel's interpretation of the dream?

3—Read Daniel 4:28-30. Why would the text mention that twelve months pass (v.28)? What does v.30 teach you about the king? How would you describe someone who is filled with PRIDE? How do you define PRIDE?

4—Read Daniel 4:31-32. What do you think the king is thinking when he hears the voice from heaven? How do you know when the Lord is speaking to you?

5—Read Daniel 4:33-35. What do you think led to King Nebuchadnezzar raising his eyes to heaven (v.34)? How would you describe this change of heart for him? When you hear the word "restored" what comes to mind? How do you praise God with your life?

6—Read Daniel 4:36-37. The king's sanity is restored. What are ways that we too can "praise, exalt and glorify the King of heaven?"

7—As you reflect on Daniel 4, what is one takeaway you can apply in your life?
