Two Points

- ❖ There is nothing that makes God have to enter into this covenant relationship with Adam.
- ❖ A covenant relationship is an agreement that expresses God's love and goodness for the man He created.

Four Covenant Features

- 1) The covenant of works was between God and Adam.
 - The covenant was according to God's terms.
 - ❖ Adam was equipped to keep the covenant of works.
 - ❖ Adam was our representative in the covenant of works.
- 2) God established that obedience to His command would define the condition of the relationship between God and man.
- 3) Death was the penalty God attached to the covenant of works.
- 4) In the promise of punishment for disobedience there is an implied promise of eternal life for obedience.

The Relevance

- ❖ Adam's test is over but the obligation to perfectly fulfill the covenant of works remains. (Rom. 3:9-20 & Galatians 3:10-14)
- The covenant of works can only be satisfied by the second Adam, who is Jesus. (Romans 5:14b-19)
