Elder Role Description

CLEMSON PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH

Brief Description: As described in Scripture, our Standards, and the BCO, elders at CPC govern the church, shepherd the flock, and teach the truth (Acts 20:28, 1 Peter 5:20) according to our four values (glory, grace, truth, and love) in four-year terms so that CPC might produce mature followers of Jesus.

Qualifications: See 1 Timothy 3:1-7

Role Requirements: An elder must...

- 1. Pursue personal holiness by God's grace, developing and executing an annual Personal Spiritual Renewal Plan, including repentance. This will be shared with the other elders.
- 2. Pray regularly for CPC, its ministries, and his flock.
- 3. Be prepared for, attend, and participate in stated and called Session meetings.
- 4. Shepherding
 - a. Shepherd his own family well.
 - b. Participate in a CPC small group.
 - c. Have pastoral contact with those on his shepherding list at least 3x times a year.
- 5. Be biblically literate, able to explain, share, and apply the essential truths of historic Reformed doctrine in one-on-one settings, small groups, or large groups.
- 6. Pray for, pursue, and proclaim the gospel to non-Christians.
- 7. Help interview potential new members.
- 8. Promote and support the activities of the church, consistently participating in weekly worship and church-wide events.
- 9. Support the church financially through voluntarily giving in keeping with Biblical principles, giving back to God as he has prospered you, not under compulsion or grudgingly, not to benefit yourself, but by way of generous grace giving, a giving which is done freely, willingly, and cheerfully (Romans 12:6,8; 2 Corinthians 9:7).
- 10. Help serve the Lord's table.
- 11. Sign the Annual Elder Affirmation each year.
- 12. Participate in an annual relational accountability "review" allowing discussion and remediation/growth, entering into each other's processes with love.
