THE TIPPING POINT “GIVE”



“I Will Give To Missions Faithfully!”



“...For God loves a person who gives cheerfully.”
- 2 Corinthians 9:7

Say:

Money is something we see and use almost every day - at stores, restaurants, and even in church. But sometimes, we forget just how powerful money can be when it's placed in God's hands. Some people think their offering is too small to matter. Others think giving isn't even that important. While giving IS important, God doesn't look at how MUCH we give - He looks at our hearts when we give!

Read:

Mark 12:41-44

Discuss:

- Where were Jesus and the disciples?
- What did Jesus think about the rich people giving lots of money?
- How much did the widow give in the offering?
- Did the woman give everything she had?

Say:

Jesus watched people giving money at the temple. Many rich people gave large amounts, but one poor widow dropped in all she had - just two small coins. Jesus said her gift was worth more than all the others because she gave from her heart and trusted God completely.

When we give to missions with a heart that is full of joy and cheer, God does something amazing with our gift. It doesn't matter if we only have a couple of coins to give. Every gift matters!

Discuss:

- Have you ever given something and it helped someone in a big way?
- What can we do so that we can give more to missions and reach more people with the love of Jesus?

Pray:

Pray that your children will have a heart of generosity and commit to giving faithfully to share the Gospel. Pray that God will use every gift - big or small - to be “The Tipping Point” to make a huge difference in the lives of people all around the world.

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
