THE TIPPING POINT “GO”



“I Will Tell About Jesus Everywhere I Go!”



“...Go into all the world and preach the Good News to everyone.”
- Mark 16:15

Say:

Have you ever thought, “I’m too young to tell someone about Jesus”? A lot of kids feel that way! But here’s the truth: God doesn’t wait until someone is grown up to use them. You are perfectly placed to reach people that adults might never meet - your friends at school, your teammates, your neighbors, or even someone in your family!

When you know Jesus, you already have something powerful to share - the story of what He’s done in your life. That story might be exactly what someone else needs to hear so they can get to know the love and power of Jesus for themselves!

Read:

Acts 8:26-40

Discuss:

- What was the name of the apostle?
- Who did Philip see on the road?
- What did the Ethiopian Official ask of Philip?
- Did the Ethiopian man choose to believe in Jesus?

Say:

God didn’t choose Philip because he was famous or older or more important. He chose him because Philip was willing to listen and share. That’s exactly how God wants to use you, too! You don’t have to be a grown-up to tell people about Jesus - you just have to be willing!

Discuss:

- Is there anything that makes you nervous to tell someone about Jesus?
- What are some ways you could show God’s love to someone this week?
- If God asked you to GO like He told Philip, what might that look like in your life?

Pray:

Pray for your children to have boldness to “GO!” Pray they will obey and become “The Tipping Point” for someone to accept Jesus as their Savior.

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
