Bethany Mission Outreach

August Mission: MMDC Personal Dignity Kits

On Friday, March 14, a line of severe weather pushed through the Midwest, bringing tornadoes, straight-line winds, and heavy rain, affecting millions of people. It's a terrible feeling, preparing for the worst, and sometimes, the worst happens. Over 50 tornadoes were confirmed across the Midwestern United States. In Missouri multiple EF-3 tornadoes struck small towns, destroying everything in its path.

But, when disaster strikes, we are ready to respond! Our partner, Convoy of Hope in Springfield, Missouri, was on the ground the day after the tornadoes, assessing the needs, and handing out food, water, and relief supplies. Convoy of Hope called Brad Walton, Midwest Mission's Director of Operations, over the weekend, to find out what supplies we had available to send.

Because of your generosity after Hurricane Helene, we had almost completely replenished our disaster relief kits and supplies. Brad was able to tell Convoy that Midwest Mission had more than enough to help. They requested: 936 Cleaning Kits to help families whose homes were damaged begin cleaning up the Debris.130 Menstrual Hygiene kits and 1,020 Hygiene Kits to help those who lost everything, have been displaced from their homes, or don't have the ability to purchase items in stores. Games and puzzles to bring joy to children, even in the midst of some of their most difficult moments.

In the past month, MMDC has provided these Kits to families in Iowa following the tornadoes and flooding. They also have been given to refugees in Ukraine, and villagers in Honduras, whose homes/villages were destroyed by the last hurricane.

As you can see, we are currently running with a operating loss of \$9,612 so far for 2025 as compared to a \$4,421 income in 2024. The main reason for this deficit is that our revenue received so far in 2025 is \$9,695 less than 2024.

The Finance team is asking that we all prayerfully consider what each of us can do to help Bethany once again attain a positive bottom line.

Exciting News!! A New Parking Lot!

The Trustee, Finance, and Ad Council Teams are excited to announce that Bethany's Upper Lot will be replaced. This project has been a long time in the making. The majority of the current lot was installed in 1967 when the church opened on Echo Lane.

Work will begin on September 15. It is estimated that it will take less than 5 days to complete the project.

3 bids from highly reputable contractors were received. The project was awarded to Northeast Asphalt, one of the longest tenured contractors in the area. The total cost of the project will be \$ 124,000. All the money from this project will come from the Capital Reserves account which was built up primarily from the Packer Parking Money and monthly Capital Reserve Allowance.

Some important bits of information:

- For any church activities the week of September 15, members should use the church lower parking lot.
- There will be 1 additional handicap parking spot located by the other spots currently in place.
- The upper parking lot will be available for church services on September 21.
