How Bethany's 2025 Apportionment Was Calculated

Every United Methodist church in Wisconsin contributes its fair share of the Conference budget. For 2025, the total Conference budget is \$6,712,885. Bethany's share, like all other WI UM Churches, was calculated using the 2023 year-end statistical reports we submitted. The formula is weighted: ½ Membership + ¾ Operating Expenses.

This means two factors are considered together: the size of our congregation and our financial resources. Churches with more members and greater expenses are asked to contribute a bit more, while smaller congregations contribute less. It's how we make sure every church carries its part of the mission fairly.
