Bethany Is Getting A New Parking Lot!

The Trustee, Finance, and Ad Council Teams are excited to announce that Bethany's Upper Lot will be replaced. This project has been a long time in the making. The majority of the current lot was installed in 1967 when the church opened on Echo Lane.

Work will begin on September 15. It is estimated that it will take less than 5 days to complete the project.

3 bids from highly reputable contractors were received. The project was awarded to Northeast Asphalt, one of the longest tenured contractors in the area. The total cost of the project will be \$ 124,000. All the money from this project will come from the Capital Reserves account which was built up primarily from the Packer Parking Money and monthly Capital Reserve Allowance.

Some important bits of information:

- For any church activities the week of September 15, members should use the church lower parking lot.
- There will be 1 additional handicap parking spot located by the other spots currently in place.
- The upper parking lot will be available for church services on September 21.

September Mission Outreach: **Kingdom Come Food Pantry**



Kingdom Come Food Pantry opened in the Fall of 2005 in Oconto Falls, Wisconsin, serving the needs of nine households. Within six months of opening, the pantry began opening every Tuesday so that clients could come weekly to shop for their households. Over the years the need for the food pantry has grown, and the pantry has grown to meet that need. Today the pantry serves more than 450 families on a weekly basis each Tuesday between the hours of 10 am - 6 pm.

From the very beginning, the board had a mission to run the pantry in the same manner that Jesus would; therefore, all that come to us hungry, are fed. An average of thirty pounds of food is given to each family per visit. Clients register upon arrival at Kingdom Come and then proceed through the drivethrough where our volunteers load the groceries into the car.


How Can You Help?

- 4. **Give donations** of household items or clothing. You are invited to take those to Oconto Falls.

On Monday mornings, we need workers to repackage items, stock shelves, and do other various onsite tasks. On Tuesdays help is needed to assist with registration, filling grocery bags, load cars, as well as other assorted jobs. What is Confirmation Class?

In the United Methodist Church, Confirmation refers to the decision a person makes to respond to God's grace with intentional commitment, publicly affirming his or her baptismal vows/affirmation of faith before the congregation. Baptism is that point where parents of a child say "yes" to God and the Church on behalf of their child. Confirmation is when the youth says "yes" to God and the Church for themselves. This class will prepare your youth to make the decision to be confirmed or not to be confirmed.

If you have a youth in 8th – 12th grade, they are invited to be in Confirmation.

And, if they want friends to be in Confirmation with them, the friends are welcome as well!
