## **VISION FOR THE WAY**

The Oxford dictionary defines the word "way" as "the method, style, or manner of doing something." What path have you chosen to achieve "the good life" and why did you decide to follow that path? (or did you even make a conscious decision?) Jesus came as a teacher to teach us the way to live rightly within God's world and invites us into a fully surrendered life by doing what He did.

# **Summary of Points**

- 1. Jesus is the only way to the Father.
- 2. Jesus invites us to live like Him to experience the life he has which includes doing the works he did.
- 3. The difficulty level of His way should not determine whether you obey.
- 4. When we lack understanding, we tend to think that our way is better than God's.
- 5. The only way to fully experience God and receive all that He desires to give is to live a surrendered life to Jesus and his purposes.

# Discipleship Actions
